**PRAYER PAL BOOKS:** Pastor Ray has purchased copies of *Praying Around the Tree* by Jodie Barrett, and they are being distributed to adult Prayer Pals. The goal is for adult Prayer Pals to send the books to child Prayer Pals prior to the first Sunday of Advent, November 30.

**COMMUNITY THANKSGIVING SERVICE:** The Warren County Community Thanksgiving Service will be held on Sunday, November 23 at the Courthouse, 3 p.m. Following the service, Thanksgiving boxes of food will be distributed to families in need. We are now collecting items for the boxes which may be left in the back entrance to the narthex. A list of needed items is on the credenza in the narthex.

**ADVENT READINGS:** November 30 begins the season of Advent. Readers for the Advent Old Testament Lesson and lighting the Advent Candle for each Sunday are needed. There is a registration sheet in the narthex. You may sign up as a family, a collective group or as an individual to help with the readings.

COMMUNITY PRAYER TREE: Plans are underway for the Warrenton community's first Community Prayer Tree, hosted by Wesley Memorial UMC. The Prayer Tree will be erected on the front church lawn. The community will be invited to meet at the Prayer Tree on November 30 and December 15, from 7-8 p.m., for prayer and placement of prayer "ornaments" on the tree. Wesley Memorial is selling "Meet Me at the Prayer Tree" sweatshirts to publicize the event. The order form is in the narthex or you may place your order with Lisa Bolton at LBolton5@nc.rr.com. Shirts are \$30. Orders and payment are due by November 15.

ADVENT DEVOTIONS: Warren Ministries United is hosting weekly Advent Devotions on Wednesdays at 12 noon at local churches. Participants are invited to bring a bag lunch, and the host church will provide beverages and dessert. The schedule for the remaining devotions is: Nov. 19, Cooks Chapel Baptist Church, 219 Cooks Chapel Rd., Warrenton; Dec. 3, Warrenton Church of God, S. Main St.; Dec. 10, Jerusalem Global Methodist Church, 850 Paschall Station Rd. Warrenton; Dec. 17, Coley Springs Missionary Baptist Church, 224 Park Town Rd., Warrenton. There will be no devotion service on November 26.

MUSIC NOTES: The tune of our opening hymn, Be Thou My Vision, is Slane, a traditional Irish melody. Slane was first published in 1909 in Patrick Weston Joyce's Old Irish Folk Music and Songs: A Collection of 842 Irish Airs and Songs. The harmonization in our hymnal is adapted from Eric Routley's arrangement in Congregational Praise, 1951. Four different settings of Slane by four different composers are our organ voluntaries for this morning's worship service.

WREATH PROJECT 2025: The Wreath Project is underway! Bows were made on Wednesday, and soon we will be pinning boxwood to wreath forms. We will gather boxwood on Nov. 28 & 29, then start making wreaths on Dec. 1. The wreaths needed for the first Sunday of Advent will be made on Nov. 24 and 25. A full schedule has been sent out via email please plan on helping with this churchwide project.

HELP NEEDED: Those who are able are asked to remain after church on Sunday, November 23, to help bring down the church's Christmas trees from a second floor Sunday School room, so that they can be erected and decorated the next week before the first Sunday of Advent.
