Todd's Take

Welcome to Worship.

Good morning and welcome! We're so glad to be together as a church

family today. If you're visiting with us, thank you for being here—we'd love to get to know you.

This morning we conclude our study of 1 John. We've journeyed through this powerful letter as simple fisherman apostle—once а encourages believers navigating difficult times. Surrounded by false teaching and a culture hostile to authentic Christianity, John speaks lifegiving truth to these early Christians. Two foundational truths stand out: God is Light and God is Love. As these truths take deeper root in our hearts, they produce the same kind of transformation John himself experienced. His greatest desire is for us to live with absolute confidence—confident that we forgiven, and called children of God.

In these closing verses, John doubles down on that theme of confidence. We can know with certainty that we are saved. We can know that forgiveness extends not only to us but to all who walk in the light. And we can know that God hears our prayers and is actively working out His purposes. Let's dive into these final verses together.
