- 1. Using this order form. Send your complete form with a check to school or drop it off in the office.
- 2. Place your order online at RaiseRight.com or on the RaiseRight app from your phone. Once registered within the system, you can place your order online and send a check with your student to school to give to their teacher. Please mark an envelope clearly that it's for a RaiseRight order already placed.

The 3rd and easiest way... RAISE RIGHT with a linked bank account.

If waiting for physical cards to arrive doesn't work for you, the easiest way to use the program is through the RaiseRight app, directly from your phone! You can use your app to order physical cards from the school, e-cards that are delivered immediately, directly to your app or you can even order physical cards that are shipped from Great Lakes and delivered directly to your home.

Register online and link your Bank Account! You can also register directly on the RaiseRight app from your smartphone! This allows you to purchase gift cards wherever you shop and pay directly with the ScripNow e-card, from your phone! No more regrets about not getting your order placed at school! Your bank account will be electronically debited, and the rebates you earn are tracked automatically. Linking your account is completely secure as it uses the same Automated Clearing House (ACH) process as direct deposit. You create a PIN to use at checkout, so you know your account is protected! No more concern about dropping off cash or checks.
