"When Life is Hard"



1 Peter 4:12-19 November 16, 2025

The Big Idea: Peter teaches us to anticipate and prepare for suffering. We need to understand the various reasons we suffer, the appropriate responses to suffering and how to move forward after a time of suffering.

1 Peter 4:12-19 (ESV)

4 ¹² Beloved, do not be surprised at the fiery trial when it comes upon you to test you, as though something strange were happening to you.

13 But rejoice insofar as you share Christ's sufferings, that you may also rejoice and be glad when his glory is revealed.

¹⁴ If you are insulted for the name of Christ, you are blessed, because the Spirit of glory and of God rests upon you.

let none of you suffer as a murderer or a thief or an evildoer or as a meddler. ¹⁶ Yet if anyone suffers as a Christian, let him not be ashamed, but let him glorify God in that name. ¹⁷ For it is time for judgment to begin at the household of God; and if it begins with us, what will be the outcome for those who do not obey the gospel of God? ¹⁸ And "If the righteous is scarcely saved, what will become of the ungodly and the sinner?"

¹⁹ Therefore <u>let those who</u> suffer according to God's will entrust their souls to a faithful Creator while doing good.

Four Sources of Suffering:



- Because the world is at war with God
- Sometimes, the source is God Himself, who in love is determined to make sure that I don't stay the same! Hebrews 12:5-6
- v.19 of 1 Pet 4 states that sometimes suffering is "according to God's will."

² A Broken World

- The moment you became a Christian was the moment your greatest Enemy increased his attacks on your life.
- Why does Satan do this Ephesians 6:11-12

(3) The Consequences of Sin

- Ours and others
- There is no end to that suffering caused by SIN!

⁴ Bad Decisions (v. 15)

• These are the things you have no one to blame for but yourself. You chose them.

<u>Five Truths About Suffering</u> [how to move forward]:

- + Suffering may not mean God has <u>let us down</u>, but that he is <u>building</u> us up.
- + Our surprise at suffering shows wrong expectations.
 - God is not here to protect us from all suffering. God is here
 to give us what we need to get through the suffering while
 He accomplishes His purposes while we are suffering, and to
 one day take us to a place where there is NO suffering.
 - o The place of no suffering is called Heaven. THIS is not heaven. This also is not Hell. So, don't expect of Earth what can only be seen and lived in Heaven.
 - + Suffering will show if we really believe what we believe we believe.
 - + Our suffering may be someone else's greatest blessing.
 - + There are 2 primary ways we can make it through suffering:
 - Entrusting our souls to a "Faithful Creator"
 - Doing good.
