Embrace Grace

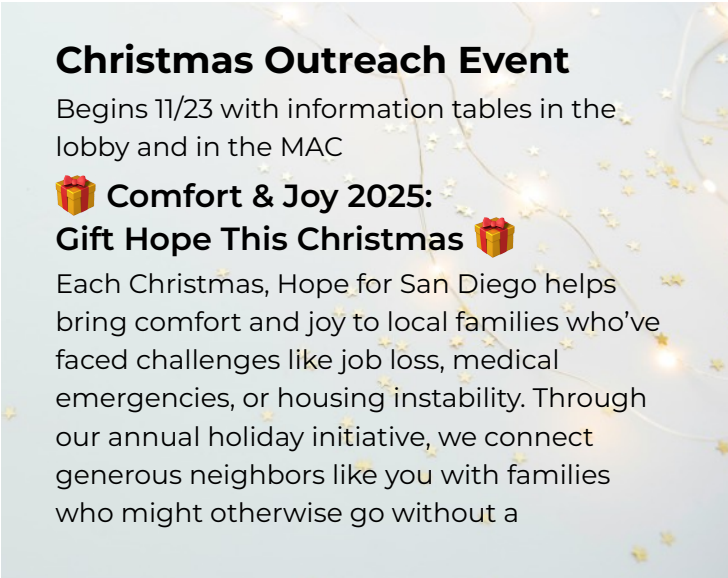

Church Family Requests

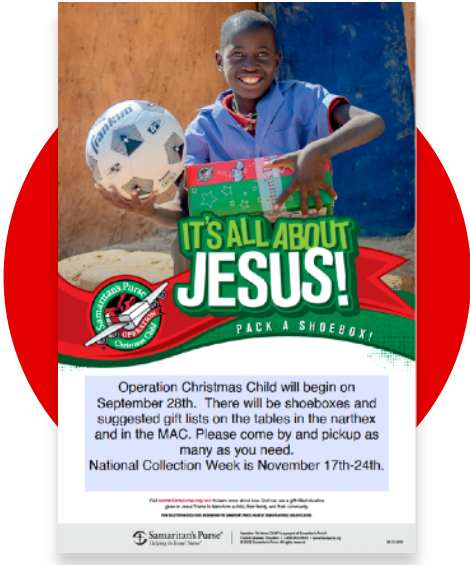
