

"Called to Ministry"

Way back in early 2003, Karen and I felt the call to go into full time ministry somewhere. We both agreed that we would go wherever God wanted us to go in the States. We did four total interviews with churches from Virginia to Indiana and two in Pennsylvania. The closest of them all was about one hour away from our hometown, and the furthest was nine or more hours away. We gave this whole process to the Lord and He worked it out in His perfect plan. I remember coming to your meet-and-greet on a Saturday night and then bringing a message on a Sunday morning. I remember it like it was yesterday, now twenty-two years ago. That was then and this is now.

You know how they say history repeats itself. We know that does at times. This is one of those times. God is now calling new leadership here at Maple Grove Community Church. I don't know how you are feeling, but I personally feel these are exciting days in the life of Maple Grove. We have so much going for us here. We have so much talent and leadership skills here that it really makes my job easy.

The Bible has a lot to say about leadership in the church, especially about pastors and deacons. The Apostle Paul writes to Timothy and to Titus about what it should look like when pursuing a pastor or deacon. Here is what Paul has to say in 1 Tim 3:1-13:

"Here is a trustworthy saying: If anyone sets his heart on being an overseer, he desires a noble task. 2 Now the overseer must be above reproach, the husband of but one wife, temperate, self-controlled, respectable, hospitable, able to teach, 3 not given to drunkenness, not violent but gentle, not quarrelsome, not a lover of money. 4 He must manage his own family well and

see that his children obey him with proper respect. 5 (If anyone does not know how to manage his own family, how can he take care of God's church?) 6 He must not be a recent convert, or he may become conceited and fall under the same judgment as the devil. 7 He must also have a good reputation with outsiders, so that he will not fall into disgrace and into the devil's trap."

Then Paul goes on to talk about the qualifications of a deacon. They are pretty much the same, starting at verse 8 "Deacons, likewise, are to be men worthy of respect, sincere, not indulging in much wine, and not pursuing dishonest gain. 9 They must keep hold of the deep truths of the faith with a clear conscience. 10 They must first be tested; and then if there is nothing against them, let them serve as deacons. 11 In the same way, their wives are to be women worthy of respect, not malicious talkers but temperate and trustworthy in everything. 12 A deacon must be the husband of but one wife and must manage his children and his household well. 13 Those who have served well gain an excellent standing and great assurance in their faith in Christ Jesus."

As Karen and I felt called to ministry, in the same way, Brent and Erin Berkeypile have felt God's call to ministry. Come and hear their story on how they got to this place in their lives. Come on Saturday, October 11th, asking questions that you may have. Come and learn more about this couple. Then come on Sunday, October 12th, during our worship hour as Brent will bring us the morning message. After the message you as a member will have opportunity to vote a simple yes or no.

Again, these are exciting times in the life of this church. Come and see what God has in store for us!
