2025 January-September Income & Expenses

As of September 30, 2025, Faith has a positive bottom line of \$12,490.

Compared to 2024 revenues, 2025 revenues are down by \$7,940. Compared to 2024 expenses, 2025 church expenses have decreased by \$16,970.

In summary, we have net a gain as of September 30, 2025, of \$12,490 to invest in future outreach and community support, Christian programming within the church, and maintenance of building and grounds.

Faith Food Pantry had two distributions in September with a total of 352 families receiving over 11,730 pounds of food (5.9 tons).


We are seeing less food available and an increase of families in need.
