Dear Supporters of Tytoo: Fall and the month of October marks the return to school for children in Haiti. October brought a glimmer of hope to a country devastated by gangs and hunger. The new UN peacekeeping force with many additional peacekeepers and more equipment brings hope for better days ahead. Conditions in the village of Simonnette have stabilized somewhat and the school has now reopened with over three hundred children in grades K to 6 in attendance. Picture below.
