Leviticus - Chapter 21-22

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. Share your experience of reading Leviticus 21-22. What kind of things went through your mind and what kind of questions came up for you?
2. What stood out to you from Sunday's message from Leviticus 21-22? In what way did Jesus speak to you personally?
3. Read 1 Peter 2:1-12. In what ways is this similar to Leviticus chapter 21? In light of 1 Peter 2:1-12, how do you think God wants us to consider the rules for priests in chapter 21? What is God asking from us today?
4. Reflect on Leviticus 21 again. a) As a group see if you can recap the different kind of rules/requirements there were. b) Consider how the priest's position in Leviticus involved forfeiting some of the freedoms of ordinary people. Because you and I are now the royal priesthood of Christ, what are some freedoms or things that you think Jesus is asking you to forfeit? C) Bonus question: How do you think we should balance striving for holiness, and knowing that ultimately it is Jesus who makes us Holy?
5. Christmas Party Discussion: Finalize your Christmas outreach plans. We hope there'll be food and people who don't know Jesus yet that you can form friendships with together! Are there any remaining details or plans you need to work on? Pray together over your party plans!
