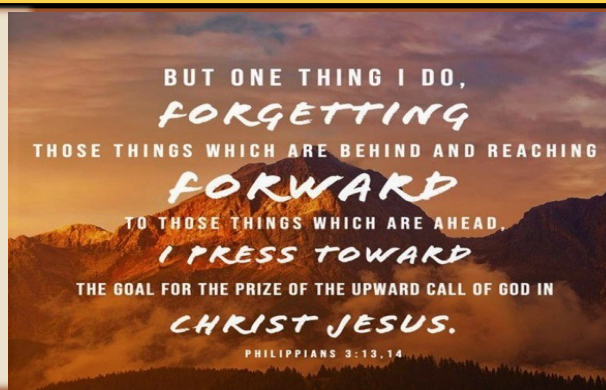

Seeing People as God Sees Them

One of the great challenges we face as Christians is learning to see people the way God sees them. Our world teaches us to judge quickly, by appearance, behavior, background, or even by how someone treats us. But Scripture calls us to a different vision. God invites us to look at others through eyes shaped by His holiness, His compassion, and His desire to save.

God sees the heart. When Samuel went searching for Israel's next king, he was impressed by Eliab's appearance and stature. But God corrected him: "For the Lord sees not as man sees: man looks on the outward appearance, but the Lord looks on the heart" (1 Sam. 16:7). We often make the same mistake. We size people up by what we can see on the surface. But every person we meet has a story, a struggle, and a soul. God is not fooled by appearances, and we should follow His lead.

God sees every person as valuable. Jesus taught that every soul has immeasurable worth. He spoke of a shepherd who left ninety-nine sheep to look for one that was lost (Luke 15:1-7). That kind of love doesn't make sense to the world, but it perfectly reflects the heart of God. If God values each soul, then the rude cashier, the distracted coworker, the neighbor who keeps to himself, and even the person who wronged us, each one is precious to Him. Their value is not determined by how they act, but by the God who created them.

God sees potential, not just problems. When Jesus looked at fishermen, He saw apostles. When He saw a tax collector, He saw a gospel writer. When He saw Saul the persecutor, He saw Paul the preacher. Sometimes we only notice people's flaws, weaknesses, or failures. God sees who they can become through His grace. When we choose to see others with that same hope, we open doors for encouragement, evangelism, and deeper relationships in the church family.

So how do we grow in this spiritual vision? Slow down your judgments. Pray before forming opinions and remember your own story. God showed mercy to you, He can show mercy to them. Look beyond behavior to the heart. Ask, "What might this person be going through?" See souls, not labels. Treat people with dignity and patience. This is the heart of Christlike love (John 13:34-35).
