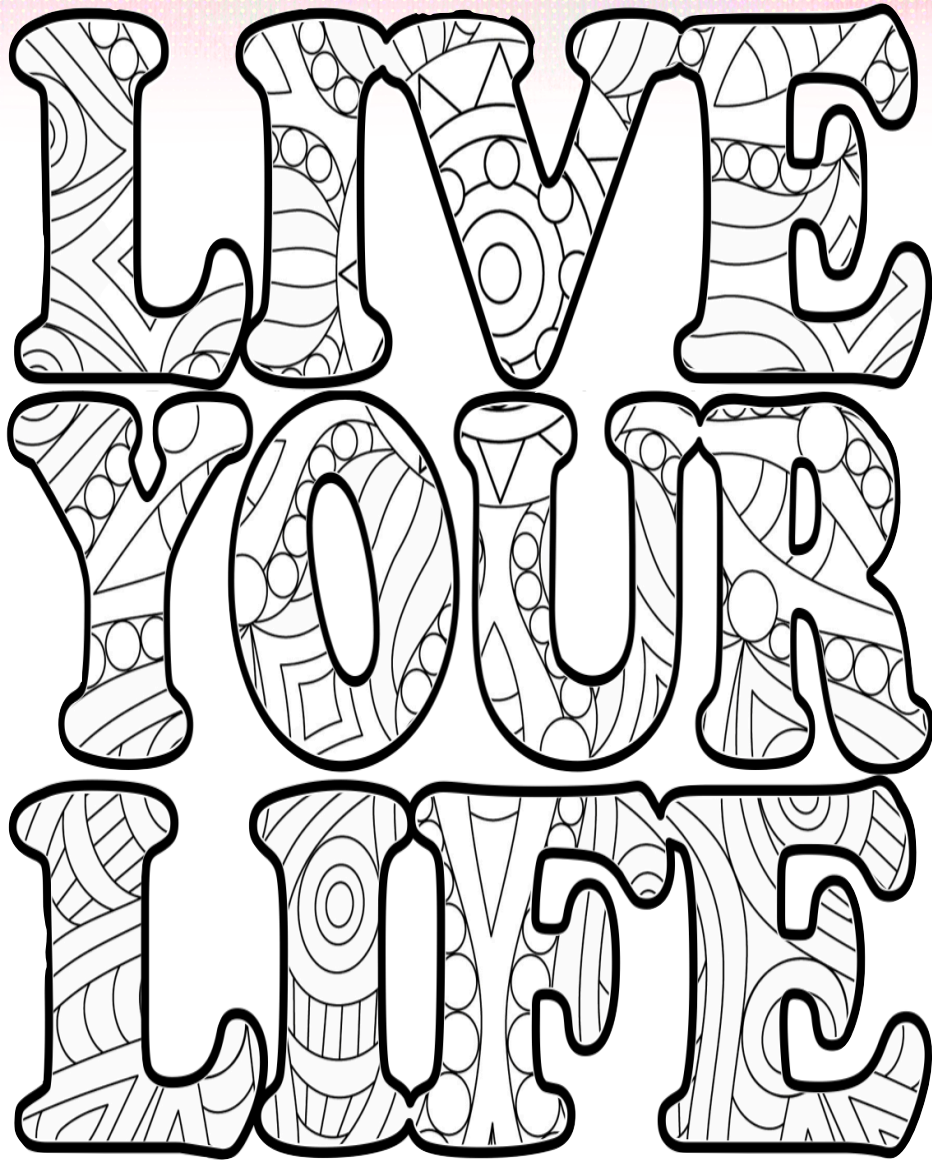

Jeremiah's Letter
