I hope this letter finds you well and encouraged in the Lord. I'm thankful, as always, for your prayers and partnership in the work God is doing here in Brazil.

This past month has been full of special blessings and opportunities! In October, we hosted a special Children's Day Sunday in conjunction with Brazil's national Children's Day holiday (*Dia das Crianças*). It was such an exciting and fun Sunday of celebration. I'm excited to share that we had **26 children** in attendance, including **10 first-time visitors**! Alongside them, we also welcomed **5 adult visitors** to the service. The church was filled with excitement as the children sang, played, and heard a clear presentation of the Gospel. I enjoyed getting to make a special tract for this promotion as well as help with the games and treats.

Among the children who've been attending faithfully are two young brothers from a nearby, very poor neighborhood. Since our VBS, they've been walking to church on their own. They've both heard the Gospel and are showing a sincere interest in learning more. Although I don't yet know if they've made personal decisions to trust Christ, they are very dear to us, and we're praying for their continued attendance as well as the Lord's protection in their family situation.

October was also our church's Missions Emphasis Month, and we were blessed to have a visiting missionary speak each Sunday. I had the privilege of sharing about the Amazon ministry—and this time, entirely in Portuguese! Though I am far from fluent, it was both humbling and encouraging to be able to share without a translator for the first time. I'm deeply grateful for the patience, love, and encouragement of my church family here as I continue to grow in the language.

After a long period of waiting and praying, I'm thankful to share that I have finally received my Brazilian driver's license! Thank you for your prayers! Unfortunately, I am still waiting for my Brazilian bank account to be finalized. I would appreciate continued prayers for this.
