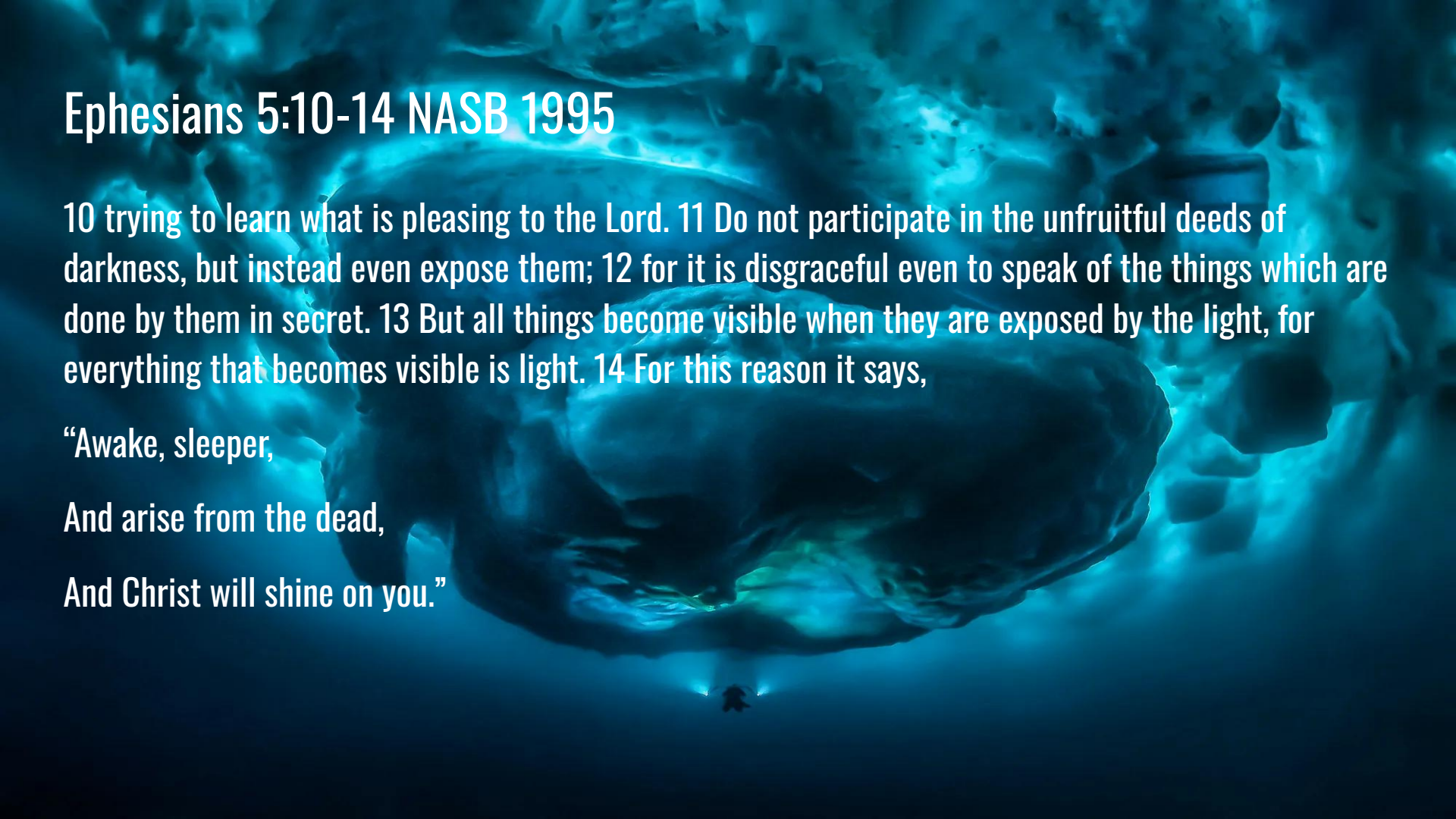
Ephesians 5:10-14 NASB 1995

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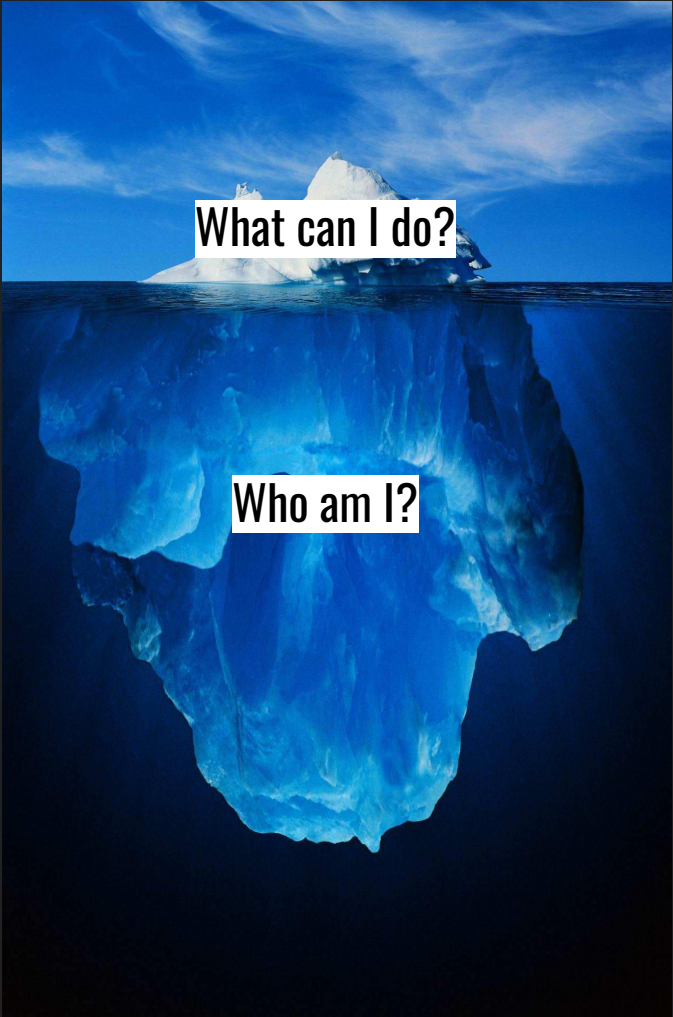
Using our Gifts

10 As each one has received a special gift, employ it in serving one another as good stewards of the manifold grace of God.

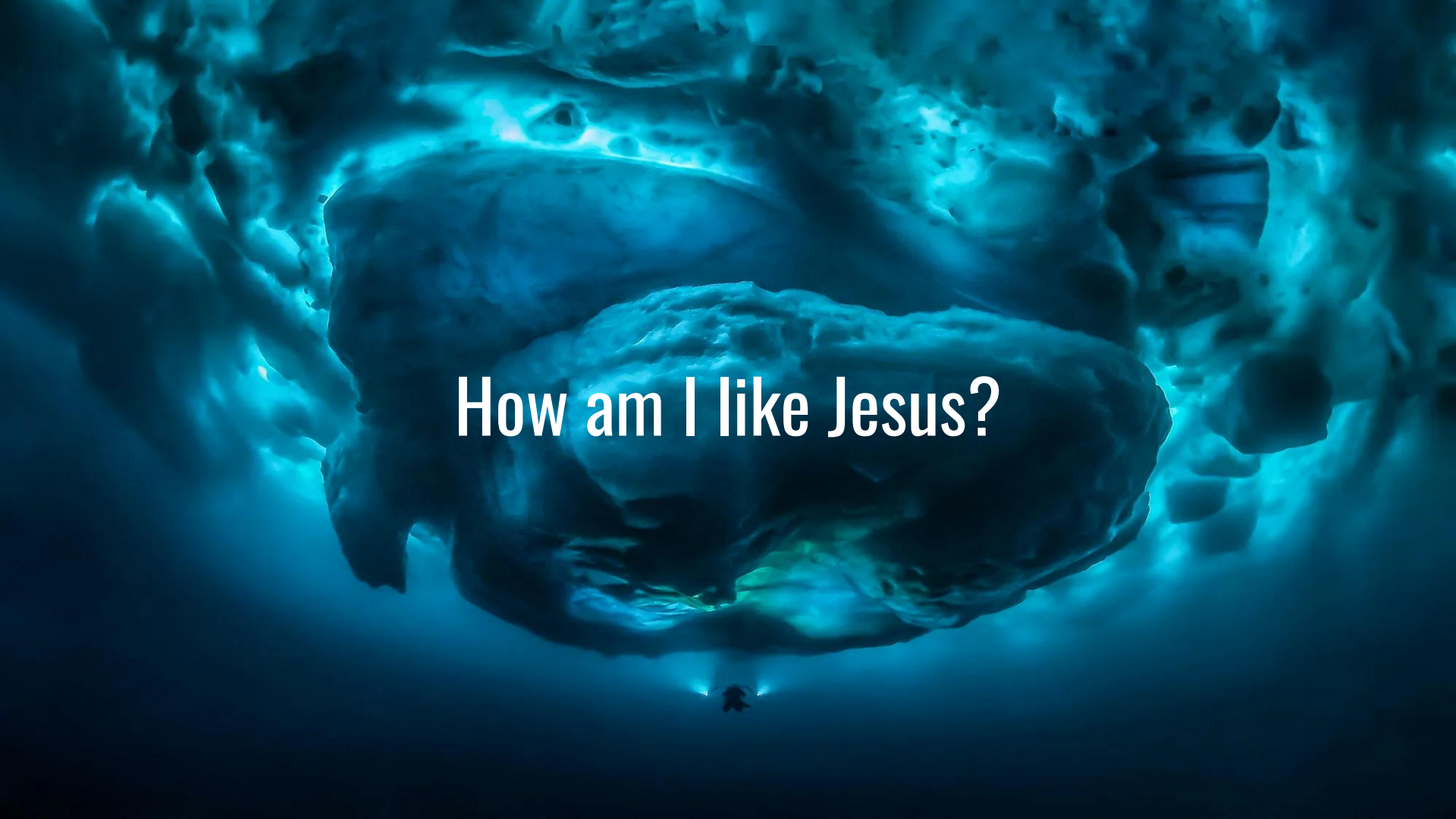

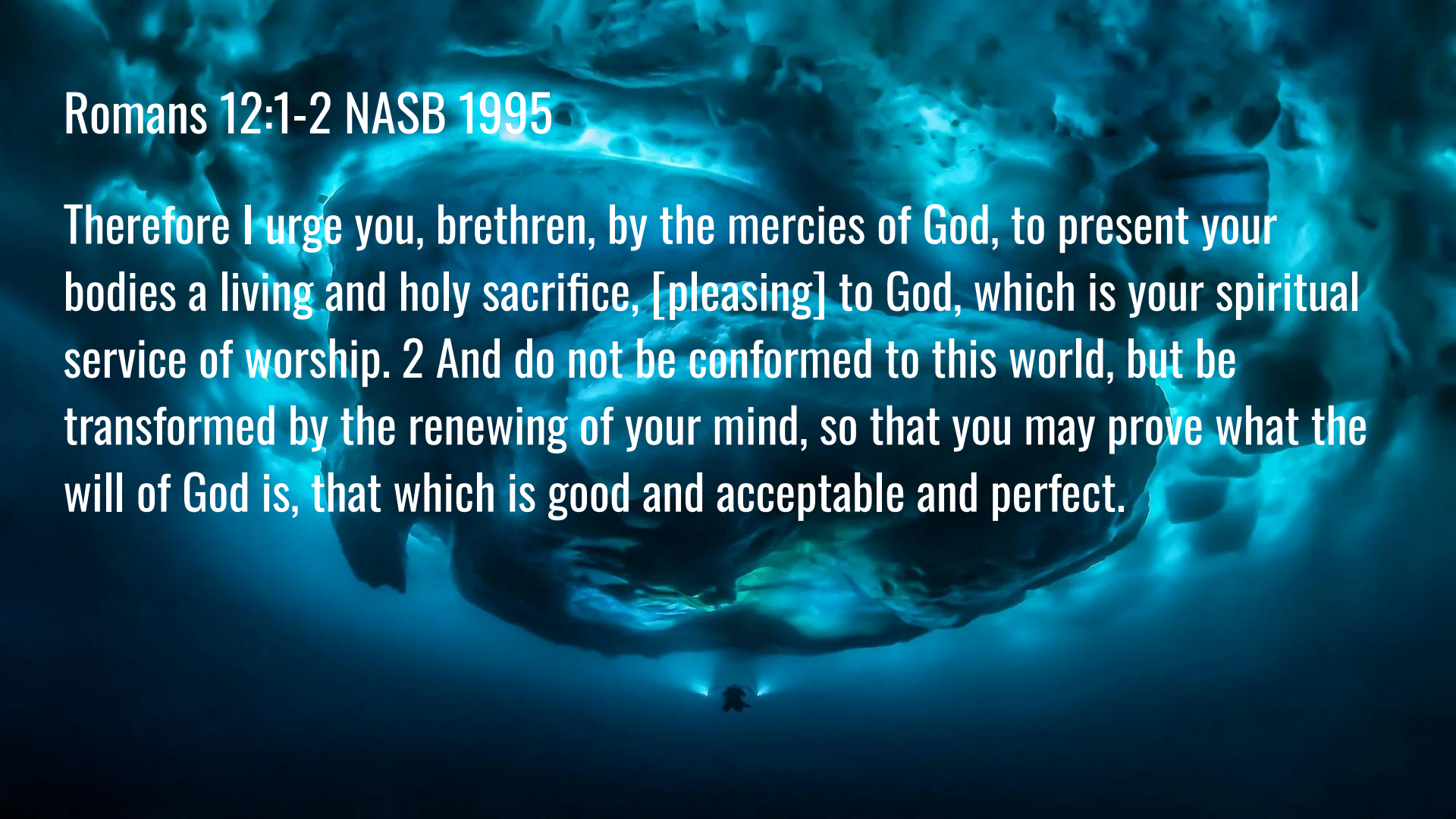

How am I UNLIKE Jesus?

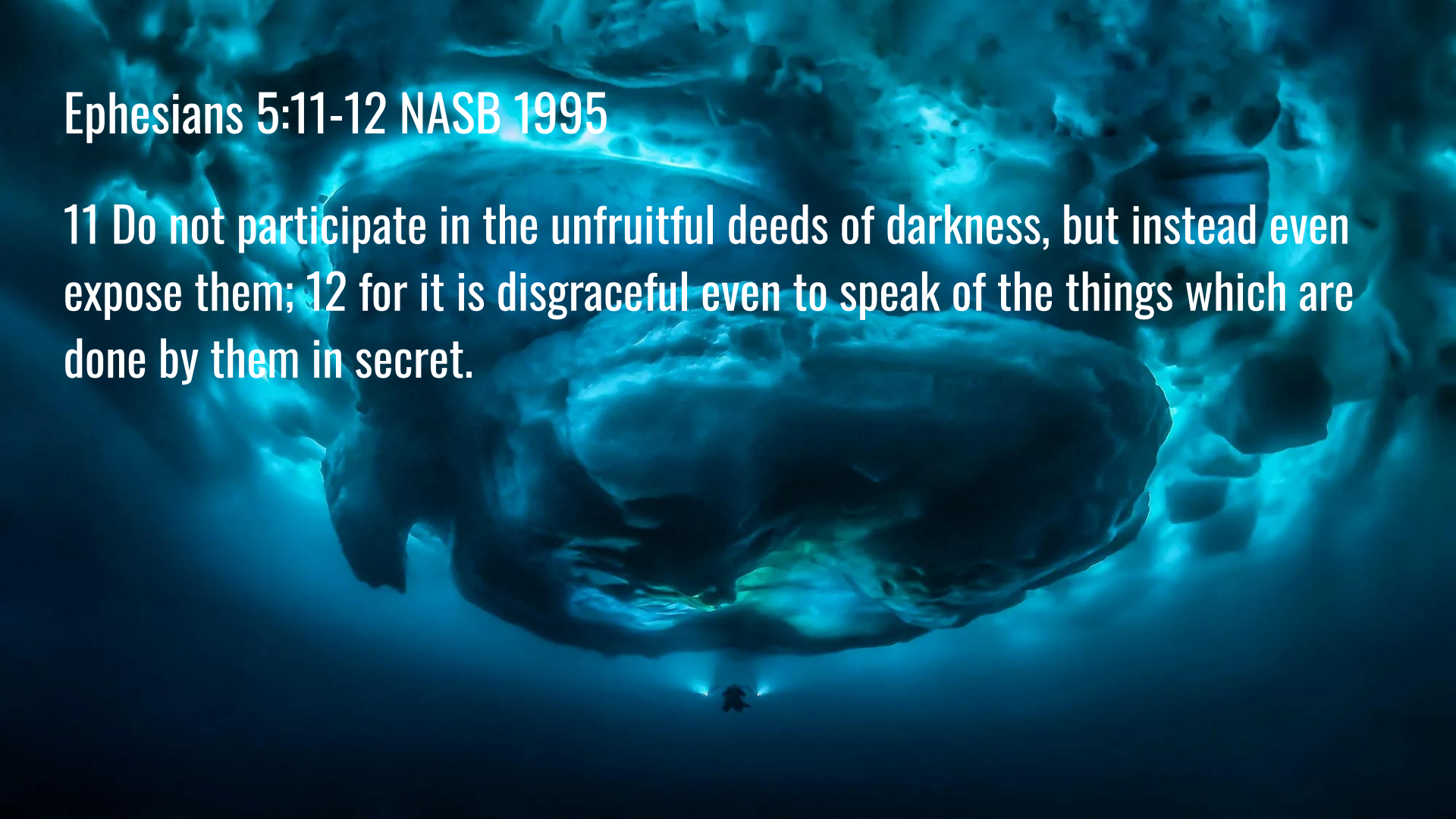
Romans 12:1-2 NASB 1995

2) Expose Unfruitful Deeds

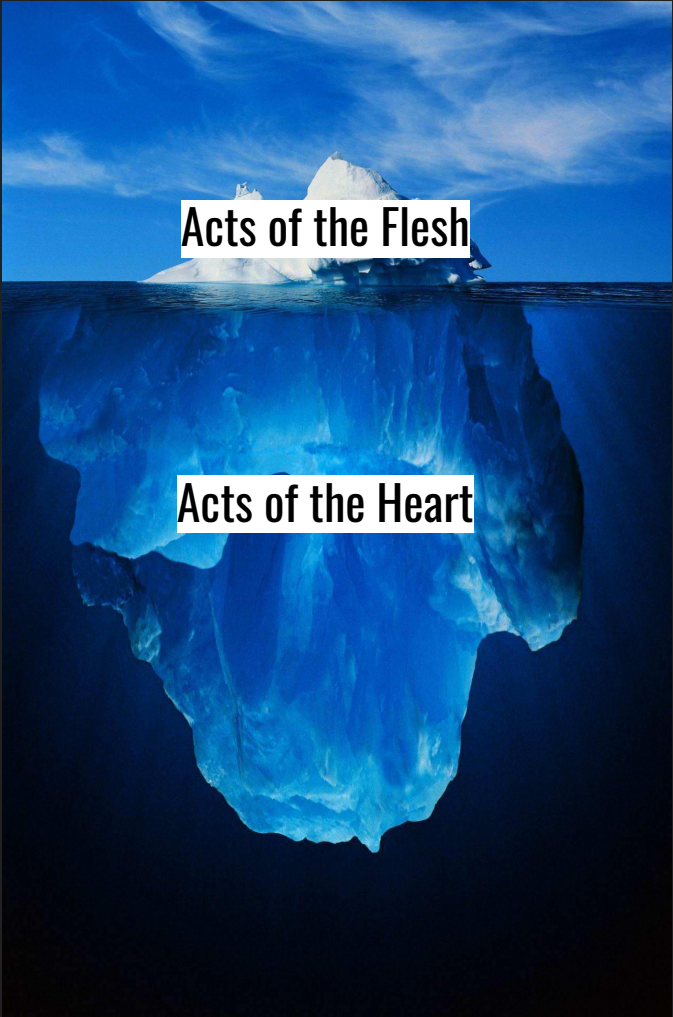

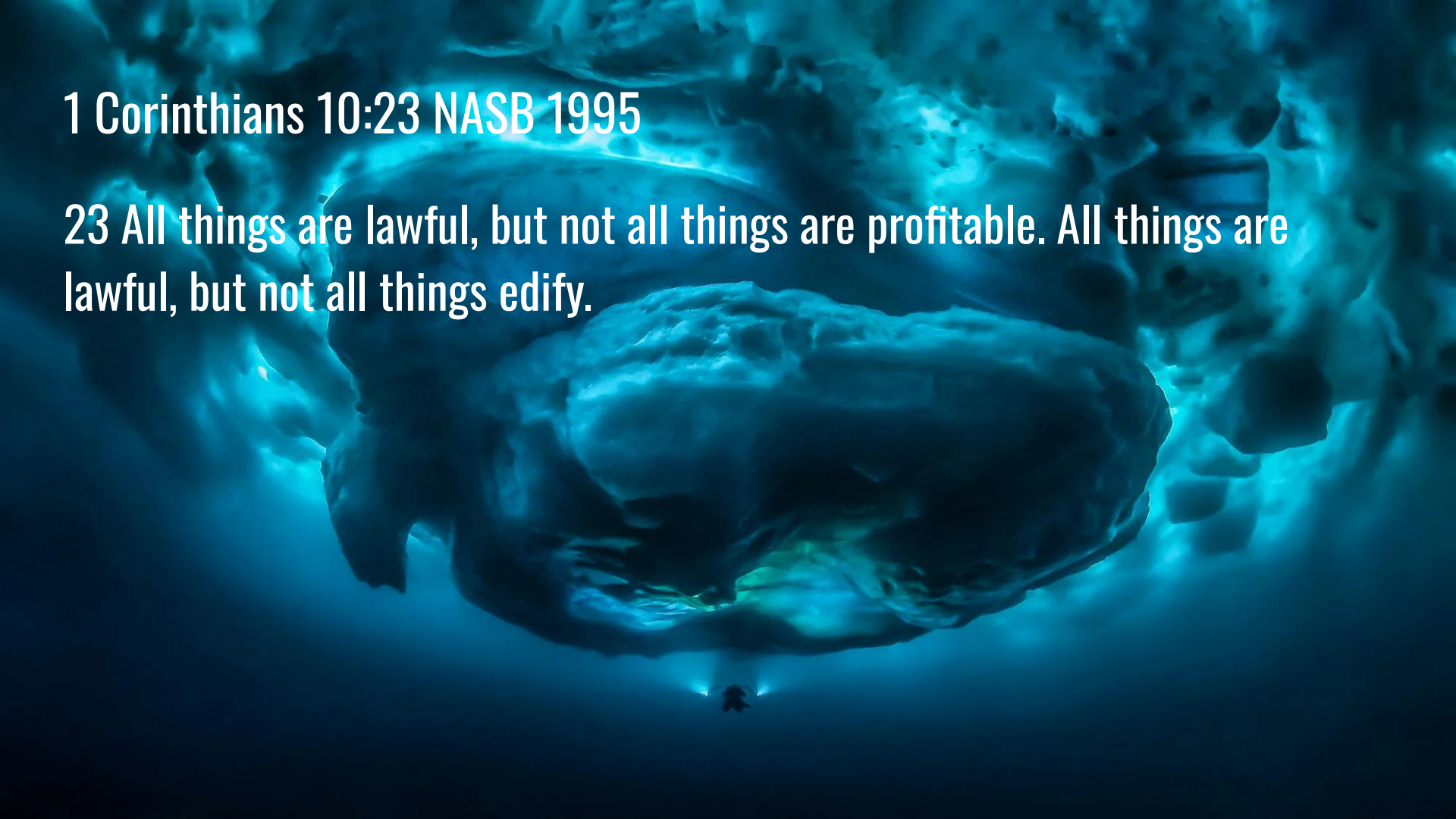

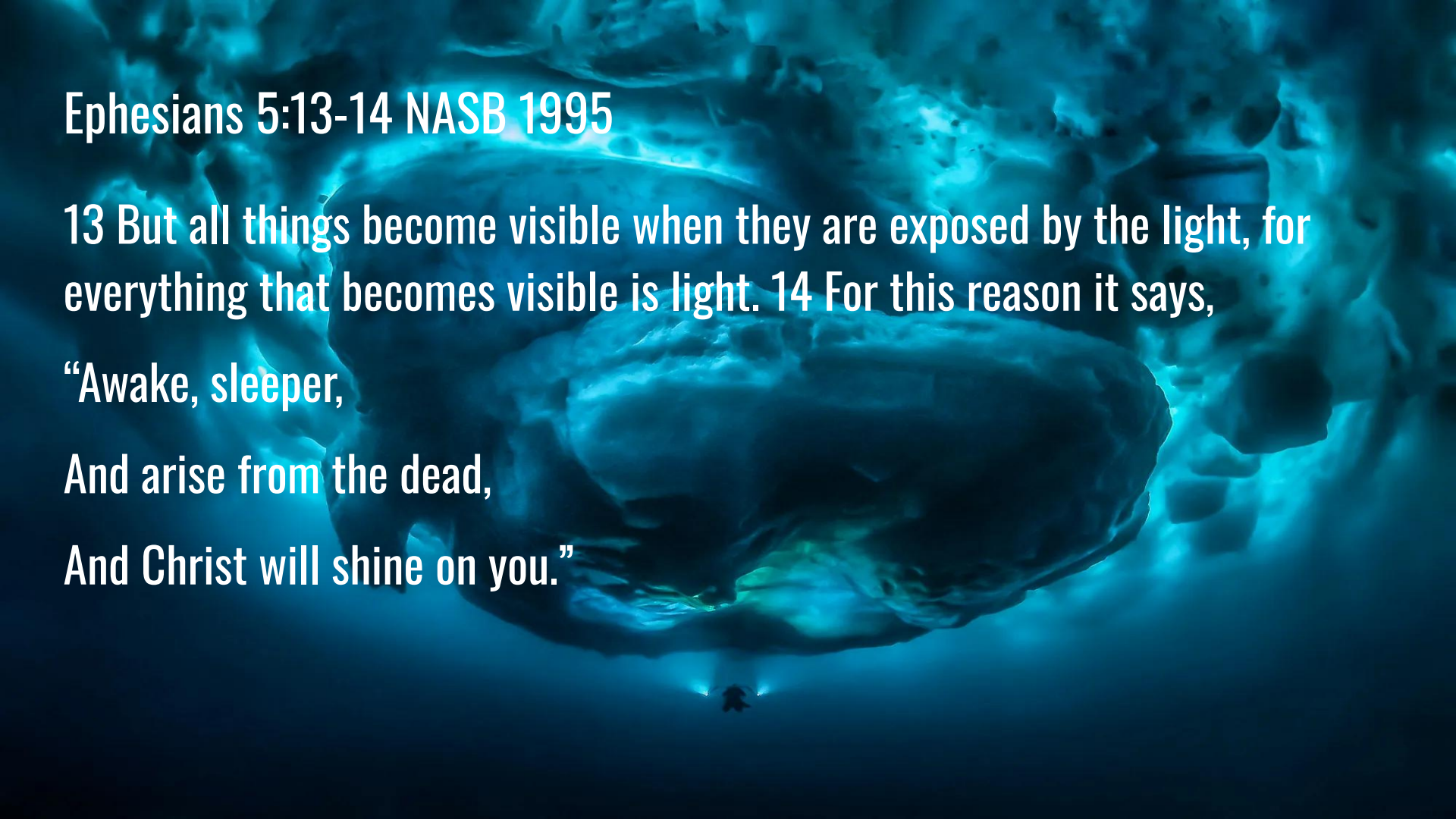

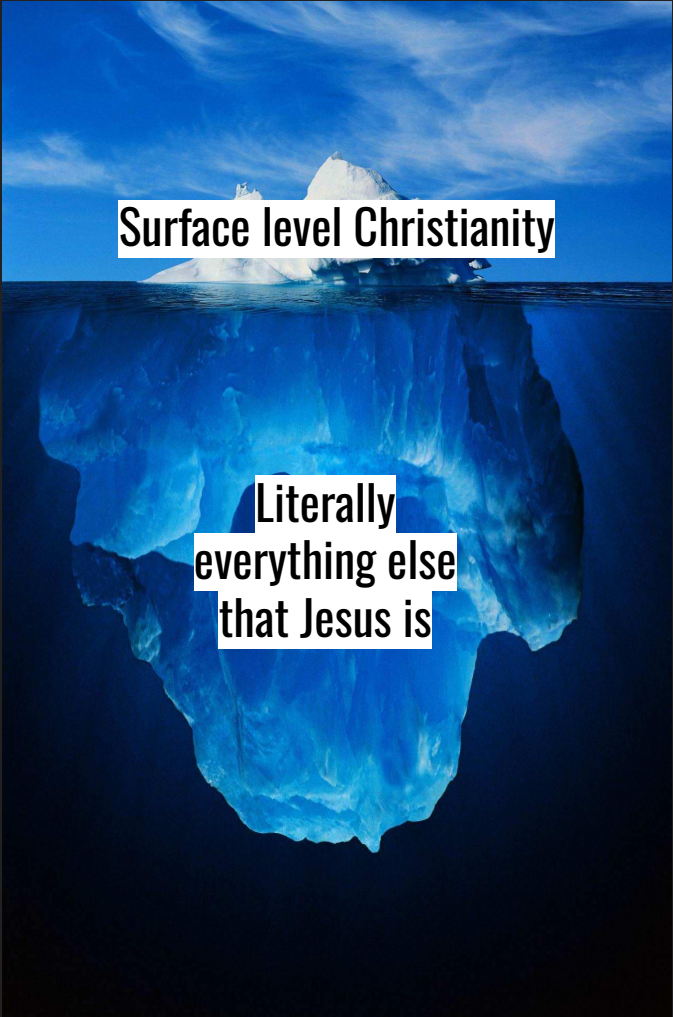
