

Life Group Study Questions Acts 28:11-31

- 1. Read Acts 28:11-31 together. As you think about this weekend's sermon, what stood out to you? What questions come to mind? Was there anything unclear or confusing?
- 2. As you think through the series on the book of Acts, what has been the most impactful part? Do you feel you have a better understanding of this book of the Bible? In what ways?
- 3. The first point of the sermon was: "The gospel creates a new worldwide family". Have you experienced the deep connection Christians have with each other? Do you view other Christians as brothers or sisters?
- 4. The second point of the sermon was: "The gospel frees us from bitterness and revenge". Read Romans 12:19-21 together. How does the gospel free us from needing to exact vengeance on people? How does Paul's example in our passage speak to that?
- 5. The third point of the sermon was: "The gospel divides". Do you have examples from your own life of this being true? Read 1 Corinthians 1:18-25. How does knowing this free us up in our evangelism?
- 6. The fourth point of the sermon was: "The gospel must be understood and perceived, not just heard and seen". Share the time that you heard the gospel and it changed your heart. Read Ezekiel 36:26-27. How should knowing this change how we pray for lost people?
- 7. The fifth point of the sermon was: "The gospel is unhindered". Have you ever been discouraged that the gospel doesn't seem to be transforming people around you? Read Isaiah 55:10-11. Why is it important to remember that God is accomplishing his work?
- 8. How can you share the gospel this week with someone? Is there someone specific that you should praying that they would understand the perceive the good news about Jesus?
