

The Covenant Making

"God has spoken - no challenge can oppose His faith."

Genesis 1:1 KJV

In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth.

God has spoken - no challenge can oppose His faith.

Before there was a world... before there was a mountain, a river, a storm, a crisis, or an enemy - there was God. And before anything appeared, God spoke. Genesis 1:1 doesn't begin with creation. It begins with the Creator. It begins with the One whose word cannot lie, whose voice cannot be challenged, and whose covenant cannot be **broken.** In the beginning, God... Not trouble. Not darkness. Not confusion. Not the enemy. God. This is where covenant begins - in the beginning of everything. He is the God who speaks and establishes, the God who calls and performs, the God who declares and fulfills. And when God opens His mouth, no situation, no power, no darkness, and no opposition can stand against His word.

And just as He spoke creation into being, He has spoken over your destiny, your family, your future, and this church.

In this moment, I sense the Lord urging me to release three divine truths that will awaken, strengthen, and propel your faith to another level.

Three Revelations to Ignite and Strengthen Your Faith

1. What God has spoken, no challenge can oppose: Matthew 24:35 (KJV) - "Heaven and earth shall pass away, but my words shall not pass away". Seasons may shift, circumstances may move, and situations may pass - but the Word of God remains unchangeable and eternal. Abraham's story is the perfect illustartion of Matthew 24:35.

God Spoke: God told Abraham he would have a son, aven when: His body was old, Sarah's womb was barren; Circumstances made it impossible.

The Challenge: Everything in the natural opposed the promise. Age opposed it; Time opposed it; Biology opposed it; Human reasoning opposed it Age resisted it; time resisted it; biology resisted it; human reasoning resisted it.

But since God has spoken, no force - human or spiritual - can challenge what He has declared. Just like Genesis 1, where God spoke and creation obeyed - Abraham discovered that God's covenant cannot be stopped. **The Covenant Making, Covenant Keeping God - whose word cannot be opposed by any challenge.** Hebrews 10:23 (NKJV) "Let us hold fast the confession of our hope without wavering, for He who promised is faithful.

- 2. What God has ordained, no battle can stop. Job 42:2 NLT "I know that you can do anything, and no one can stop you." When God ordains a destiny, no battle no enemy, no setback, no injustice can stop it. God gave Joseph dreams revealing that he would rise, lead, and preserve his family. We can say that Destiny was spoken and Purpose was ordained. But as soon as God revealed it, battles came from every side. Battle 1 Jealous Brothers: They hated him and sold him, but they couldn't stop what God ordained. Battle 2 Slavery: He was taken to a foreign land, but God was still with him. Battle 3 False Accusation: He was thrown into prison unjustly, yet even prison couldn't cancel God's plan. Battle 4 Forgotten by Man: He was forgotten for two years, but God never forgot him.. Romans 8:31 (KJV) "If God be for us, who can be against us?" No battle can prevail against God's ordained plan.
- 3. What God has begun, no force can undo. Philippians 1:6 NKJV "He who has begun a good work in you will complete it until the day of Jesus Christ. Nehemiah's story is one of the greatest demonstrations that what God begins, no force of darkness can undo. God began the work by placing a divine burden in Nehemiah's heart (to rebuild the broekn walls of Jerusalem, to restore the dignity of God's people and to revive true worship). This "good work" did not begin with Nehemiah's strength—it began with God's calling. Opposition Immediately Rose Up:

Opposition Immediately Rose Up: As soon as Nehemiah obeyed God, battles began: Sanballat and Tobiah mocked the work; Threats and discouragement came; They plotted to attack; They spread lies and false accusations.

The purpose of the enemy was simple:

- Stop what God had begun.
- Interrupt the work.
- Break Nehemiah's focus.

But No Force Could Undo What God Began Despite every attack: The people kept building; Nehemiah kept praying; The vision kept advancing; God kept strengthening them. Nehemiah 6:15 - 16 NLT So on October 2 the wall was finished-just fifty-two days after we had begun. When our enemies and the surrounding nations heard about it, they were frightened and humiliated. They realized this work had been done with the help of our God.

In Conclusion

God's Word is fulfilled - John 1:14 ESV - And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we have seen his glory, glory as of the only Son from the Father, full of grace and truth.

Not even death could silence Him; Not even the grave could hold Him; Not even hell could stop Him.

- God's covenant is sealed: Your destiny is not held together by your strength It is held together by the blood of Christ.
- God's good work in you will be completed: The One who died and rose again
- Because of Christ...
 - No challenge can overturn His Word.
 - No battle can stop His purpose.
 - No force can undo His work.
 - No enemy can cancel His covenant.
 - No darkness can silence His voice.
 - No weapon can defeat His promise.
