Our speaker, Missy Paden, had four inspirational messages throughout the weekend.

- The Importance of Intimacy with our Heavenly Father. Jesus teaches us in His word how crucial prayer is in our Christian walk. In Luke 5:16 But Jesus often withdrew to lonely places and prayed. Matthew 14:23 After He had dismissed them, he went up on a mountainside by himself to pray. Throughout our day, pray without ceasing.
- Our Identity in Christ & Anchor Ourselves in Truth. John 1:12 Yet to all who did receive him, to those who believed in his name, he gave the right to become **children of God**. Ephesians 2:10 For we are **God's handiwork**, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do. Scripture reminds us to **see ourselves as the Lord sees us**.
- **Trusting God in Difficult Situations** Psalm 34:18-19 The Lord is close to the brokenhearted and saves those who are crushed in spirit. The righteous person may have many troubles, but the Lord delivers him from them all. Romans 12:12 Be joyful in hope, patient in affliction, faithful in prayer. We need to look to Jesus, the problem solver rather than the problem.
- Walking in the Fullness of God. Psalm 116:1 I love the Lord, for he heard my voice, he heard my cry for mercy. Ephesians 3:19 and to know this love that surpasses knowledge that you may be filled to the measure of all the fullness of God.

We had a large beautiful wooden cross in our conference room brought to us by Missy's son. On Sunday morning we had a meaningful communion and prayer time at the foot of the cross. Prayers were answered and burdens lifted!

Our retreat was a wonderful mix of Bible study, worship, fellowship, quiet time, crafts and plenty of good food! Always a blessing when the common bond of Jesus brings all generations of ladies together.


