Jesus and Zacchaeus

Luke 19:1-10

Jesus entered Jericho and was passing through. 2A man was there by the name of Zacchaeus; he was a chief tax collector and was wealthy. 3He wanted to see who Jesus was, but because he was short he could not see over the crowd. 4So he ran ahead and climbed a sycamore-fig tree to see him, since Jesus was coming that way.

<u>5</u> When Jesus reached the spot, he looked up and said to him, "Zacchaeus, come down immediately. I must stay at your house today." <u>6</u> So he came down at once and welcomed him gladly.

7All the people saw this and began to mutter, "He has gone to be the guest of a sinner."

 $\underline{8}$ But Zacchaeus stood up and said to the Lord, "Look, Lord! Here and now I give half of my possessions to the poor, and if I have cheated anybody out of anything, I will pay back four times the amount."

9 Jesus said to him, "Today salvation has come to this house, because this man, too, is a son of Abraham. 10 For the Son of Man came to seek and to save the lost."

"Happy are those . . . whose sin is covered."

Zacchaeus was amazed to find that Jesus had forgiven his sins. Psalm 32:1 says our sins are covered. Find out what it is that covers our sins by coloring the leaves with an **x** in the leaf pile.

for the Saviour he wanted to see.


And when the Saviour passed that way,


We beg you, friends, to value those who toil among you, and are your leaders in the Lord's service, and give you counsel.
