pray. So Advent has a double meaning. We celebrate the birth of Christ, and we wait in hope for his return at the end of time. God's incarnation, or presence in Jesus, is a beautiful mystery to contemplate at this time of the year. Jesus's experience of God, his unity with

the Creator, is part of the message he wanted to share with all of us, not just in words but in our own experience. Jesus invites us to experience that oneness, that unity of spirit, he had with God. He saw this divine spark in the people he met. It did not matter if they were male or female, Jew or Gentile; all have God in them and are worthy of love and respect. Advent is a time to celebrate in a particular way the God present in each of us.


