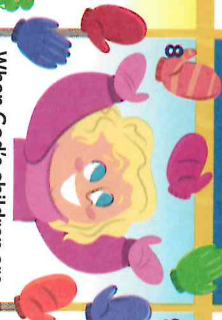


Here's a

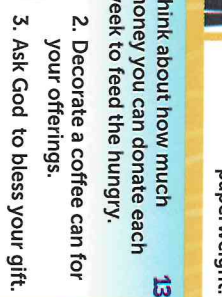

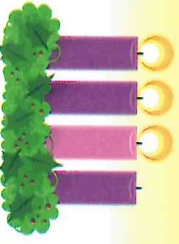

child.

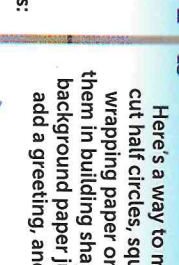

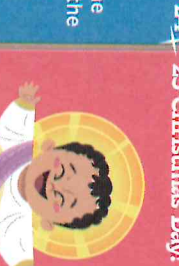
