Questions:

3. Where else in the Bible does the theme of unbelief appear?
4. Why do you think Zechariah struggled to believe even after seeing an angel?
5. Do 'silence' and 'waiting' help us in the presence of doubt? If so, how?
6. Where does Zechariah find hope, and how can we find hope in our waiting?
