REFLECTION ON GOD'S LAW

from Exodus 20:1-17 & N.T. corollaries, ESV

Leader: You shall love the Lord your God

with all your heart

and with all your soul and with all your mind.

People: This is the great and first commandment. (Matt. 22: 37-38)

Leader: God spoke all these words, saying, "I

am the Lord your God.

You shall have no other gods before me."

People: For although there may be socalled "gods" in heaven or on earth... yet for us there is one God. (1 Cor. 8:5-6)

Leader: You shall not make for yourself an idol.

People: What agreement has the temple of God with idols? For we are the temple of the living God. (2 Cor. 6:16)
