Due to the incredibly generous giving of our members, together with the support of Church Council and the LCAV District, we are thrilled to announce that - to date - we have raised just over 90 % of the fund needed for the stage one and two works.



The stage one works, which included new wiring and refurbishment of the console (the bit that gets played) are now complete and we look forward to moving onto stage 2 in the near future, which will see the fitting of a new blower (the bit that pumps the air into the pipes) and ultimately, in stage 3, the addition of new groups (ranks) of pipes.
