Discussion Points

1. "And lead us not into temptation," (Matthew 6:13a NIV)

"Temptation comes from our own desires, which entice us and drag us away. ¹⁵ These desires give birth to sinful actions. And when sin is allowed to grow, it gives birth to death. (James 1:14-15 NTL)".

How does these verses shape our understanding about temptation and God's character, His guidance, and the spiritual battles we face daily?

2. In what ways have you personally experienced God 'delivering you from evil'—whether through conviction, community, Scripture, or the

prompting and power of the Holy Spirit? How can we, as a small group, better support one another in this journey?

3. As citizens of God's unshakeable Kingdom, how does acknowledging that 'Yours is the kingdom, the power, and the glory' shape the way you pray and live each day? In what practical ways would our daily decisions and lifestyle change if we genuinely trusted that the Almighty God reigns sovereign over all?
