

THE GOOD NEWS

Wait for the Lord; be strong, and let your heart take courage! — Psalm 27:14

December is a very full month around here! If you joined us for worship on a Sunday near the end of November, you heard a long list of announcements about all of the opportunities for gathering, serving, and celebrating in the next few weeks. I was greeted with that same sense of abundance—and a little bit of overwhelm—as Aimee and I reviewed the contents for this very newsletter. This time of year has us all double-checking our calendars as we hope to squeeze in as much festivity as we can.

It's already Christmas at retail stores and your dentist's office; Thanksgiving weekend inundates us with ads for Black Friday sales and more more more. Your place in the planning of your Christmas festivities will influence how "behind" you already feel you are.

It's my job, as your pastor, to remind you to slow down.

The season of Advent shows up in stark contrast to our cultural moment. This may annoy you, as I insist that you light a candle and take a deep breath, when you've got a mile-long to-do list. Martin Luther suggested that everyone should spend thirty minutes each morning in prayer, and that those who are too busy should pray for sixty minutes. This is, of course, to emphasize the necessity of time spent in stillness and in connection with God and one another. When we are whipped into a frenzy, it is very challenging to interrupt ourselves for long enough to notice the presence of God.

This is especially ironic for us, as the arrival of God in our midst—the birth of the Christ child, Jesus of Nazareth—is what this season is about. In the midst of our chaos, our exhaustion, our excitement, our loneliness, our joy, our grief, our real lives, God shows up. Each year, I am deeply relieved when we reach this season, because I know that Jesus is *finally* coming. That, as I look around at the brokenness of our world, God is coming to make us whole again. God is coming to make all things new.

Advent reminds us to get ready. And not as another thing to add to your list! You don't need to change anything about yourself to be ready to receive God's love bursting into the world. The readiness can be a gift you give to yourself, time spent preparing your heart for good news of great joy.

Over the next four weeks, we will anticipate the coming of the Lord. We will sing songs of hopeful expectation, imagining what our weary world might look like once he is here. We will light candles as the days get darker, reminding us of the light he brings. We will pray for peace.

As we worship together on the four Sundays of Advent, I will invite you into some (small, simple) practices of reflection and prayer and connection that will accompany you in this season. The overall theme of Advent is waiting, but in neither a bored way nor an anxious way. We'll focus each week on waiting with hope, peace, joy, and love. We'll wonder about what the arrival of the infant Jesus will mean for us as individuals, as a community, and as a whole world.

And on Christmas Eve, we'll sing Silent Night. I can hardly wait!

Congregational Meeting- Dec. 14th

On December 14, 2025, we will be holding Part 1 of our Annual Congregational Meeting to elect council members and officers for terms beginning in January 2026. We will also hold a Special Congregational Meeting to make minor changes to our Constitution that have been recommended by the Synod. We will also vote on proposed changes to our constitution regarding the Mutual Ministry Committee.

As the changes we will be voting on are relatively minor in nature, such as typographical corrections recommended by the Synod, and a clarification to provision that establishes our Mutual Ministry Committee, we will not be holding a specific time during our post-worship fellowship hour to discuss the changes. However, the recommendations are available for review by any member of the congregation. Please contact Aimee in the church office for copies of the text if you wish to review. The text will also be available on the day of the congregational meeting. The Council recommends approval of these changes.


