

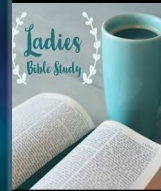

Our Ongoing Call to Compassion

Compassion has always been at the heart of God's character, and therefore it must remain at the heart of His people. In every age, God calls believers not simply to moments of compassion, but to a lifestyle of compassion, a daily posture of seeing needs and responding with Christlike love.

Scripture reminds us that compassion flows from understanding how God has treated us. Paul writes, "Be kind to one another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, as God in Christ forgave you" (Ephesians 4:32). Tenderheartedness is not optional. It is the natural response of a heart touched by grace.

Jesus modeled this perfectly. He was moved with compassion when He saw the crowds, the sick, the hungry, and the hurting. His compassion was not merely a feeling; it was action. He fed, healed, taught, comforted, and most of all, gave Himself for us. When we look at the cross, we see the ultimate example of compassion expressed in sacrificial love.

Our world needs that same compassion today. Families struggle silently. Brothers and sisters in Christ carry burdens we never see. Neighbors fight battles we do not fully understand. A gentle word, a patient response, a listening ear, or a simple act of service can reflect Christ in powerful ways. The believer's ongoing call to compassion is not about dramatic gestures, but faithful, everyday Christlikeness. Compassion shows up when we choose understanding over irritation, mercy over judgment, and service over self-comfort. It grows when we slow down long enough to notice the needs around us and remember the mercy God has shown to us.

As Paul reminds us to put on compassionate hearts in Colossians 3:12. Compassion is something we choose to wear each day, just like clothing. And when the church puts on compassion, the world catches a glimpse of Jesus. May we be a people who never tire of showing kindness, extending grace, and carrying one another's burdens. For in doing so, we walk in the footsteps of our Savior.
