Petition:	To break the strongholds of addiction in the lives of our children and loved ones.
Beginning:	Start Date and Time: December 6, 2026 12:01am
End:	End Date and Time: December 8, 2026 12:01 am
Fast:	 Follow the leading of the Holy Spirit based on your medical condition: Day 0 – before the Fast and Intercession, a 60-minute Zoom call. Day 1 – Partial Fast (skip one meal or whatever you have given up for 6 hours), and a 15-minute Zoom call. Day 2 – Sunrise to Sunset Fast (water only, or whatever you have given up for 12 hours), and a 15-minute Zoom call. Day 3 - Full Day Fast (liquids only, or whatever you have given up for 24 hours), and a 15-minute Zoom call. Follow-up one day per week for three weeks – 15-minute Zoom calls. Note: The stated fast is a recommendation, choose the food medically sound for you and or the items from which you will forgo during the fast e.g. social media, Internet, Face Book, Secular TV What you will relinquish in this time as a statement of submission to God that He and your loved ones are more treasured than your sacrifice.
Faith Statement:	Lord God, I believe and affirm that you are the true and living God. You, who created the world, the sun, the moon and the stars, the creator of all heavens and earth, the giver and sustainer of life. I affirm and believe you are the triune God: Father, Son and Holy Spirit. I believe that you came in the flesh as Jesus Christ, fully God and fully man, who is the Word, the truth and the light, to deliver us from sin and the whiles of the evil one, unto salvation. I believe that all good gifts and all good things come from you, therefore I trust and have faith in you that my children's lives and the lives of my loved ones, shall reflect the promise of Your peace, power, protection and have overcome the stronghold of all addictions through the power of your Word and Holy Spirit. In the name of Jesus, I believe in my heart and profess with the words of my mouth that your Word is true, and you have delivered them from the destruction of addition and all of its influencers. Amen.
