POLICY

The purpose of this policy is to provide guidelines for the conduct of memorial and funeral services at Peninsula United Church.

- 1. As compassionate people, trusting in a compassionate God, the Congregation of Peninsula United Church offers funeral and memorial services to members and adherents of the congregation, as well as to community members on request.
- 2. Memorial/Funeral services are conducted by a Peninsula United Church Minister, or a designated member of the congregation approved by Strategic Leadership Council (SLC) (UCC Manual).
- 3. Fees are established by the Peninsula United Church SLC and apply equally to members, adherents, and community members.
- 4. The Memorial Service Fee Schedule is also used for Zoom Memorial Services and Graveside Services. See 9.0 Appendix A: PUC Event and Rental Fees Schedule
- 5. Requests to provide music for memorial and funeral services held at PUC will be offered to the Music Director/Music Leader with the right of first refusal.
- 6. All those in attendance, including soloists and musicians must comply with the current BC Health & Safety Protocols for Peninsula United Church as outlined on our PUC online website.
