
REFLECTING ON GOD'S WORD


While Matthew and Luke generally based the structure and content of their Gospels on Mark, each also drew on his own unique sources. Today's reading comes from a uniquely Lucan section. Using material known only to him, Luke's goal in this segment is to affirm Jesus' identity as a prophet who ministers to the poor and to show how Jesus found acceptance and rejection from the people.

Today's Gospel account, the raising of the son of the widow of Nain, identifies Jesus as a prophet whose ministry is focused on the vulnerable in society. In this way, Jesus fulfills the prediction he made in Nazareth, to act in the power of the Spirit given to him and to fulfill the Scripture (Luke 4:17-21). Not only does Jesus fulfill Isaiah's words, but he imitates Israel's prophets, especially Elijah, who raised the son of a widow in Zarephath (see Luke 4:25-26). As remarkable as this is, Jesus' action is a resuscitation, not a resurrection, similar to and in line with the great deeds of the prophets. Thus, the focus remains on his ministry to the vulnerable widow and its impact on the crowd. They identify him as a great prophet and view his ministry as God's visitation to his people. In the face of suffering Jesus' actions demonstrate his lifegiving power which he offers to all people.

SCRIPTURE INSIGHTS: THE COMMEMORATION OF ALL THE FAITHFUL DEPARTED. YEAR C

The main themes for All Souls' Day in Year C remain consistent with its core purpose: remembrance, prayer, and gratitude for the departed. Key themes include divine mercy and justice, the communion of saints, and the solidarity in prayer, all viewed from an eternal perspective. It's a day of reflection on life, death, and the hope found in the Christian faith for eternal peace.

- **Remembrance and Prayer:** The central theme is to pray for and remember all the faithful depart-
- Divine Mercy and Justice: The observance emphasizes God's mercy and justice for those who have died.
- The Communion of Saints: All Souls' Day connects us with the living and the dead through the "mystical body of Christ", which is the communion of saints.
- **Solidarity in Prayer:** It highlights the solidarity that Christians share in prayer...a bond that death does not break, but strengthens.
- **Hope and Eternity:** The day provides a hopeful perspective on death, by viewing life from the perspective of eternity and the promise of eternal life.

All Souls' Day focuses on those still waiting to get into heaven, whereas All Saints' Day honors all the Saints in heaven. Both days remind us of the hope we have in eternal life. (Young-Catholics.com)
