REFLECTING ON GOD'S WORD


Today's Gospel trains a Lucan eye on the crucifixion. While Matthew, Mark, and Luke all recall how Jesus was mocked, Luke limits this abuse to three voices: the leaders of the people, the soldiers, and one of the criminals crucified with Jesus. The leaders sneer as they call Jesus the "Christ of God", the soldiers mockingly call Him the "King of the Jews", and the criminal derisively calls Him "the Christ". What unites them, however, is the way each challenges Jesus to act as savior. Only Luke had identified Jesus as the savior in the infancy account (Luke 2:11), and now Jesus' tormenters challenge Him to save himself. The mockers imply that to save Himself, Jesus must come down from the cross. This is highly ironic because for Jesus, staying the course to death is how He saves. Salvation consists not in political liberation or the ability to avoid physical death. Rather, Jesus' forgiveness offered to those who are killing Him (23:34) and His interaction with the repentant criminal, the only one to make a confession of faith, point to how He saves. Through His death, Jesus restores God's people by the forgiveness of sins. It is as this type of savior that He exercises His kingship. ~Fr. Stephen Lampe



THEMES:

THE SOLEMNITY OF CHRIST THE KING, YEAR C

This Solemnity reminds us that Jesus is our true King. His kingdom is different from earthly kingdoms because it is built on love. mercy and sacrifice.

- Jesus as King: Jesus is not a king who rules with power and force. He leads with love, humility, and service.
- **God's Kingdom is Eternal:** Earthly rulers come and go, but Jesus' kingdom will never end. His rule is one of peace and justice.
- Salvation Through Jesus: The second reading reminds us that Jesus rescues us from sin. He brings us into His kingdom and makes us part of His family.
- Mercy and Forgiveness: Jesus forgives the criminal on the cross. His kingdom is open to all who turn to Him with faith.
- **Humility and Suffering:** Jesus does not save Himself from the Cross. His suffering shows that true kingship is about sacrifice, not power.
- **Faith in Jesus:** The good thief believed in Jesus even when others mocked Him. His faith brought him the promise of eternal life.

This week's readings remind us that Jesus is a different kind of king. He rules with love, mercy, and justice, and His kingdom will never end. (Young-Catholics.com)
