Today is the Second Sunday of Advent. In this week's Gospel, Matthew describes the work and preaching of John the Baptist. John the Baptist appears in the tradition of the great prophets of Israel, preaching repentance and reform to the people of Israel. In this reading, John directs a particularly pointed call to repentance to the Pharisees and Sadducees.

John's baptism can be understood as an anticipation of Christian baptism. John himself alludes to the difference between his baptism and the one yet to come. In this reading, John makes it very clear that his relationship to the Messiah yet to come, is one of service and

> subservience. John's preaching of the coming of the Lord is a key theme of the Advent season. As John's message prepared the way for Jesus in the first century, we, too, are called to prepare ourselves for Jesus' coming. We respond to John's message by our repentance and reform of our lives. We are also called to be prophets of Christ, who announce by our lives, as John did, the coming of the Lord.
