TODAY'S TOPIC: THE PROPHETS TELL OF GOD'S SON

A long time before Jesus' birth, God told His people that He would send His Son. God used individuals, called prophets in the Old Testament, to tell people that Jesus would be born.

Like pastors today, prophets helped people know about God and taught them about how God wanted them to live. Prophets would tell people what God told them to say. One of those prophets was a man named Isaiah. God told Isaiah, "She will birth to a son and call him Immanuel." (Isaiah 7:14) He also told Isaiah that He would send his son to help people. (Isaiah 9:2-7) God also used a prophet named Micah. Micah told the people that Jesus would be born in Bethlehem. (Micah 5:2) The people waited for a very long time for God to send His promised Son. They waited and they waited. Finally at just the right moment, and in just the right place, Jesus was born to Mary and Joseph. God sent his Son just as the prophets had said.
