Luke 1:30-32 (NIV)

Scripture; But the angel said to her, "Do not be afraid, Mary, you have found favour with God. You will be with child and give birth to a son, and you are to give him the name Jesus. He will be great and will be called the Son of the Most High.

That same day, an angel (pause) appeared to Joseph in a dream.


