### Introduction:

*1 Corinthians 7:19.* We still have commandments we need to \_\_\_\_\_. We must \_\_\_\_\_.

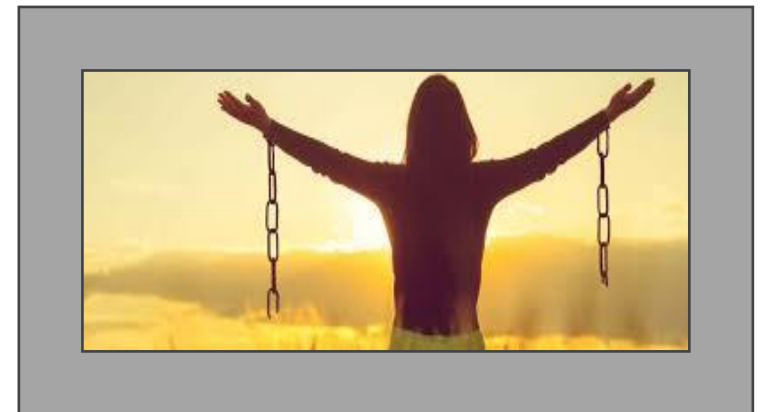
### Applications:
