The Ranch: For Rent



The Ranch is now officially <u>listed for rent</u> at market-rate. Recently we learned that best practice is to rent our property at market-rate to individuals, and that we can only rent at belowmarket rent to another charity. Our first priority was to find a charity partnership, however, after an extensive search for a charity partnership and finding none that suited, the decision

has now been made to list The Ranch at fair market value. We want to be clear about a few important points for potentially interested applicants from within Grandview:

- The Ranch's rental will be a straight up I year lease at market rent (\$5000/month), without the requirement for a "vision" or "mandate" for community housing, etc.
- As such, priority will not be given specifically for Grandview Congregants. At this time and season of Grandview, we feel there is benefit of separating people's place of worship with their housing security. Since The Ranch was last seeking new tenants (2021), we've learned that having too much overlap can threaten people's sense of relationship with the GC community, and we don't want to potentially cause harm in the future.
- That being said, we will welcome applications from all, including members of the GC community, with all these cards and caveats on the table.

Please feel free to <u>circulate the listing</u> to anyone who might be interested. Applications will be evaluated as they are received, and the Stewardship Committee will be helping to make the final decision on tenancy for 2026.
