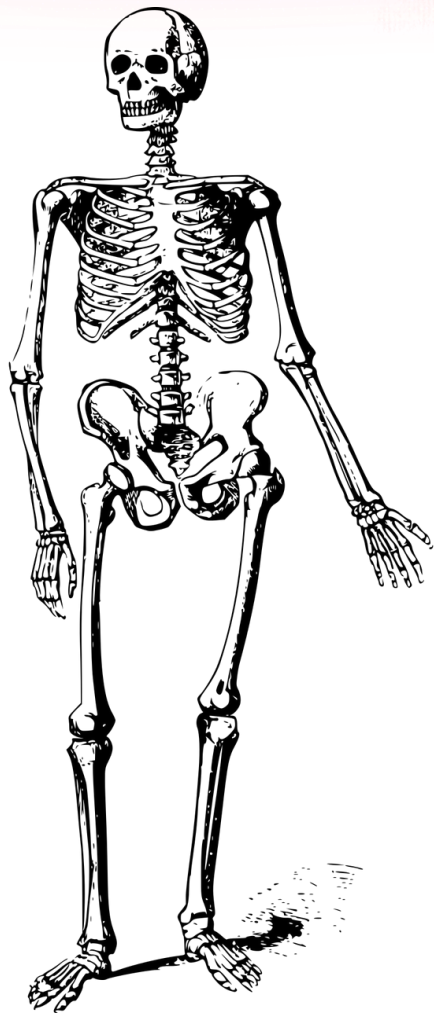


## Draw & Color

## The Dry Bones

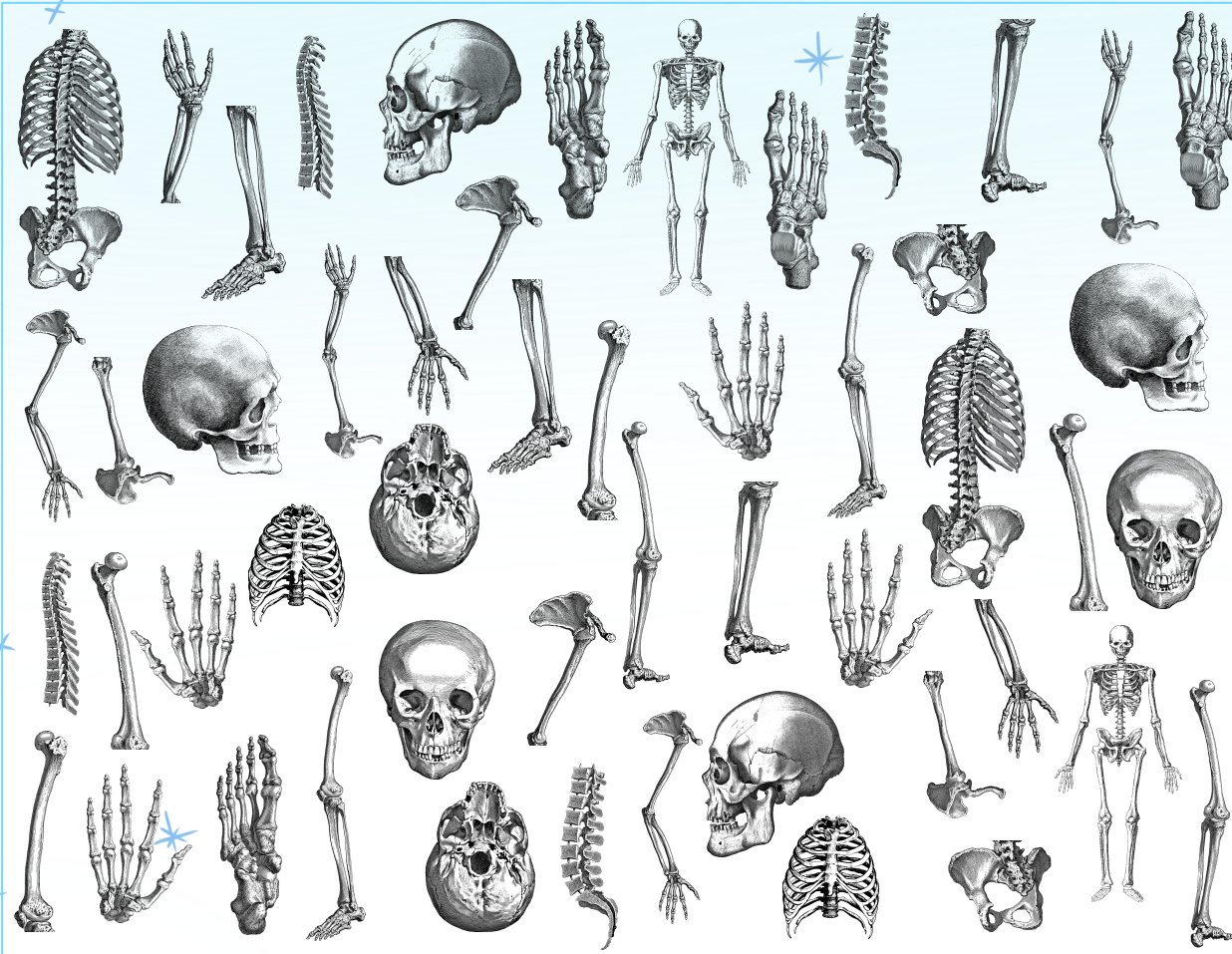
#### VISION
