One of the biggest joys to share is that I am five months pregnant! We found out right before my hand surgery, and by God's grace I was still able to move forward with the procedure using only a tourniquet block on my arm, without any anesthesia. Baby girl is growing well and is expected to arrive around March 20.

I also have wonderful news about my health. After the surgery on my right hand, not only did the numbness and pain disappear completely, but the symptoms in my left hand also vanished. My doctor said this sometimes happens when the nerve on one side is relieved. This has been such an unexpected and encouraging gift. My lungs continue to be monitored, but the pulmonologist reassured me again that the small emphysema spots are stable and not a cause for concern.

Another joyful update is that I just finished recording the Advent devotions for the month of December, using *Let Earth Receive Her King* by Alistair Begg. I recorded everything in the new studio in our home, and what a gift this space has been. My prayer is that these video devotions would reach many in the Deaf community throughout Brazil.

The church plant continues to grow and surprise us. We're meeting new people, shepherding more souls, and asking God for deeper relationships and long-term discipleship.

Please keep praying for the sign language classes we plan to begin soon at the church and at the local school. Please pray for the right students, a sweet learning environment, and genuine, long-term fruit in the Deaf community and their families.


