What You'll Do

 - Maintain cleanliness and organization of the pantry, freezer(s), walkin cooler, reach-in cooler, storage bins, shelves and cupboards and other kitchen equipment.
 - Ordering and stocking our consumable products, ie. Paper plates, cups, napkins, utensils, etc.
 - Maintain an accurate inventory of all hospitality related items, ie.
 Cookware, plates, cups, utensils, etc.
 - o Launder the kitchen laundry using the church washer and dryer.
- Assist in the development of kitchen procedures and practices.
- Work Alongside Ministry Leaders Partner with pastors, event leaders, and ministry teams to make the best use of our kitchen and hospitality spaces.
- Equip for Excellence Make sure our volunteers and staff are confident, trained, and (when needed) certified to serve in safe and sanitary ways.

- Care for Weddings Work with couples from the point of interest in using our space for their wedding though to the completion of their event.
- Care for Funerals Assist the Congregational Life Pastors as needed. Be the liaison between McKernan and the family helping with details related to the reception and the caterer the family has chosen to use. Arrange setup and takedown of the reception following the service.

You will report to the Senior Pastor and their designated representative, the Facilities Manager. Because at McKernan, hospitality is more than a task — it's a ministry that opens the door for people to experience the love of Jesus.
