But the tax collector, standing some distance away, was even unwilling to lift his eyes up to

heaven, but was beating his chest saying, "God, be merciful to me, a sinner!" I tell you this man went down to his house justified. Luke 18:13, 14

Many people today are familiar with Charles Dickens' classic tale, <u>A Christmas Carol</u>. In it, we remember the stingiest man in London, Ebenezer Scrooge, is visited by three ghosts on Christmas Eve. They show him scenes from his past, present, and future to demonstrate how miserly he has become. Scrooge happily mends his evil ways when he learns of the horrible fate which awaits him unless he repents.

In Jesus' day, "Scrooges" were commonplace. They were called "publicans" or "tax collectors". The publicans were Jews who collected taxes for the Romans. The more taxes they collected, the more money they made. This system encouraged them to cheat the Jewish people by charging higher taxes than were justified. So the Jews despised the publicans on two accounts...they worked for the hated Romans and they oppressed their own people.

Jesus demonstrated, in word and in deed, that even the publicans needed salvation. The most common charge leveled against Jesus was that He ate with publicans and sinners. As we enter into this season of Advent and Christmas, we need to remember that everyone is welcome in the kingdom of God.

Holy Lord, keep us from the sins around us by helping us to focus our minds on the teaching of Your holy word. May we be faithful to live in Your word and to proclaim Your word to others around us so that they can keep away from sin and deepen their relationship with

You as well. We ask this in Jesus' name. Amen.

The Quilters will meet on Saturday December 13 at St. John's from 9-3:00. We


