“Of Repentance Unto Life” Ch. 15, sec 4-6*

4. As there is no sin so small, but it deserves damnation; so there is no sin so great, that it can bring damnation upon those who truly repent.
5. Men ought not to be content with a general repentance, but it is every man’s duty to endeavor to repent of his individual sins, individually.
6. As every man is bound to make private confession of his sins to God, praying for the pardon of them; upon which, and the forsaking of them, he shall find mercy; so, he who brings scandal on his brother, or the church of Christ, ought to be willing, by a private or public confession, and sorrow for his sin, to declare his repentance to those who are offended, who are then to be reconciled to him, and in love to receive him.
