# Day 1 - Monday (Luke 1:26-33)

# \* Advent Day 8, Love

God's love often arrives in ordinary moments. Mary's quiet life was interrupted by heaven's plan.

→ Pray: "Lord, make me ready to say yes when Your love calls."

# Day 2 – Tuesday (Philippians 2:5-8)

# \* Advent Day 9, Love

Love humbled itself. The King took on the form of a servant.

🙏 Ask: Where can I choose humility over pride this week?

### Day 3 – Wednesday (John 3:16-17)

### \* Advent Day 10, Love

God's love doesn't condemn; it rescues.

Share: Tell someone today that God loves them right where they are.

### Day 4 – Thursday (1 John 4:9-10)

#### \* Advent Day 11, Love

This is love, not that we loved God, but that He loved us first.

Reflect: Rest in the truth that His love for you isn't earned.

#### **Day 5 – Friday (Luke 1:38)**

# \* Advent Day 12, Love

"I am the Lord's servant," Mary said. Her love showed through obedience.

Pray: "God, help me love You with my yes."

#### Day 6 – Saturday (Ephesians 3:17-19)

### \* Advent Day 13, Love

God's love is wider, longer, higher, and deeper than we can imagine.

 $\stackrel{\frown}{\sim}$  Pray for GBBC to be rooted and grounded in that love.

### Day 7 – Sunday Reflection

#### \* Advent Day 14, Love

Think of one way you saw God's love move through someone this week.
