



Summer Fun Information 2026

Monday through Friday 8:00am to 5:30pm

- AGES: Entering Kindergarten through entering 2nd grade - Children who have completed 2nd grade are not eligible to attend Summer Fun.
- 9 WEEK PROGRAM: Monday, June 1, 2026 – Friday, July 31, 2026
(Closed Friday, June 19th and Friday, July 3rd)
- COST: Full time - 5 days per week \$60.00/day
Part time - 2-4 days per week \$65.00/day
Less than 10 days per summer - \$70.00/day (if space is available)
- REGISTRATION FEE: \$50.00 per child/\$75 family maximum
- SNACK FEE is assessed and is based on weekly days of attendance.
\$50 for 5 days per week, \$40 for 4 days per week, \$30 for 3 days per week, and \$20 for 2 days per week. This is a one-time fee.
- ENROLLMENT PAPERWORK will be mailed by late March 2026 and must be completed and returned by May 1, 2026.
- DEPOSIT of \$200.00 is due on May 1, 2026, and is applied toward July 2026 tuition.
- TUITION is based on actual days scheduled and is due by the 10th of the month. Changes in schedule require two weeks notice. Families will receive a fee schedule once days of attendance are confirmed.

- LUNCH and SNACK



Children bring their own lunch and water bottles daily. Please pack a hearty and healthy lunch with ALL food groups included. We need lots of energy for these fun-filled days! A microwave is available for heating lunches. Water is available with lunch, snacks, and all day long. Morning and afternoon snacks are provided and include at least two food groups. They are nutritious and delicious! We will provide a safe table for students with food allergies.

- DEVON POOL

Pool days are great at Summer Fun! Children must have a UA Parks & Recreation pool pass or pay the daily admission* to Devon Pool. The group attending the pool leaves Holy Trinity around 1:00pm and returns by 4:30pm. Children attending full time go to the pool 3 days per week. Children who attend three or four days go to the pool 2 days per week. Children who attend two days go to the pool 1 day per week. All pool days are weather permitting. Holy Trinity provides ample afternoon snacks at the pool. Some children want to buy a treat at the pool. It is the parents' decision whether to send money with their child. If you do send money, we ask that you limit your child to one food or ice cream purchase per day. (No pop please!) Of course, each child will be responsible for his/her own money. Please discuss this with your child in advance; we will also remind the children of the guidelines.

- SPRAY sunscreen labeled with your child's name. Please turn in sunscreen with your registration paperwork. Sunscreen will be left at Holy Trinity for the summer.
- One change of clothes (may be kept in child's backpack)

- A water bottle labeled with your child's name.
- Backpack or pool bag for our walking trips to the pool
