PRAY FOR UNREACHED PEOPLE GROUPS IN AFRICA:

From EU Daily Prayer: Pray for Christ-centred Churches among all African Peoples. The Joshua Project estimates that 510 million of Africa's 1.5 billion people are in the 1044 unreached people groups, representing 33.2% of the population. Although Africa is now regarded as the most Christian continent, there is still much to be done in establishing Christ-centred Churches among all African Peoples.

CAR conflict: On Monday, December 1, 2025, there was an attack on the population in Mboki, CAR by rebel forces. The CEEC President informed me that 213 households have moved to the Catholic church compound for safety. Another 190 households fled to the hospital. Seven men and 13 women were beaten with sticks and cut with machetes. Members of the CEEC church are among those wounded. The President is asking for our prayers.

Christmas Outreaches: Many of our members will be putting Christmas outreaches for Muslims. Please pray for this in NR, DR, Islands, and various other places. Ask for the right people to come, for wise, winsome, and courageous proclamation of the gospel, and for Muslims to embrace the gospel message and Jesus Himself. Nyamwezi of Tanzania.

Tanzania: Continue to pray for peace and safety in Tanzania following the Oct 29 elections which were marked with protests, internet blockages, and underlying uncertainty. There seems to be mostly calm contentment within in the region of the Nyamwezi. Pray for Christian believers across the country, especially among youth, to seek God's leading in all they do and say, and to trust that God's hand is in control. Pray for those in the church who lead within the community and sit among the leaders of the land. Pray for boldness to preach truth and for God's guidance in all conduct.
