



FALL AND WINTER 2025-2026

Thank You everyone who gave to the "Building Fund" and "School Capital Improvements" over the summer. Due to your generous gifts the sanctuary renovations and the gym room projects have been FULLY FUNDED!!! Starting from October 1st through January 31st, the church council has authorized the capital giving envelopes to go toward the following projects:

Building Fund: Exterior Updates – Total project estimated cost - \$20,000

School Capital Improvements: Walk-In Freezer – Cost estimates including installation are approximately \$30,000 (\$15,600 is needed to fund this project)


SR YOUTH LOCK IN ON FRIDAY, JANUARY 2


