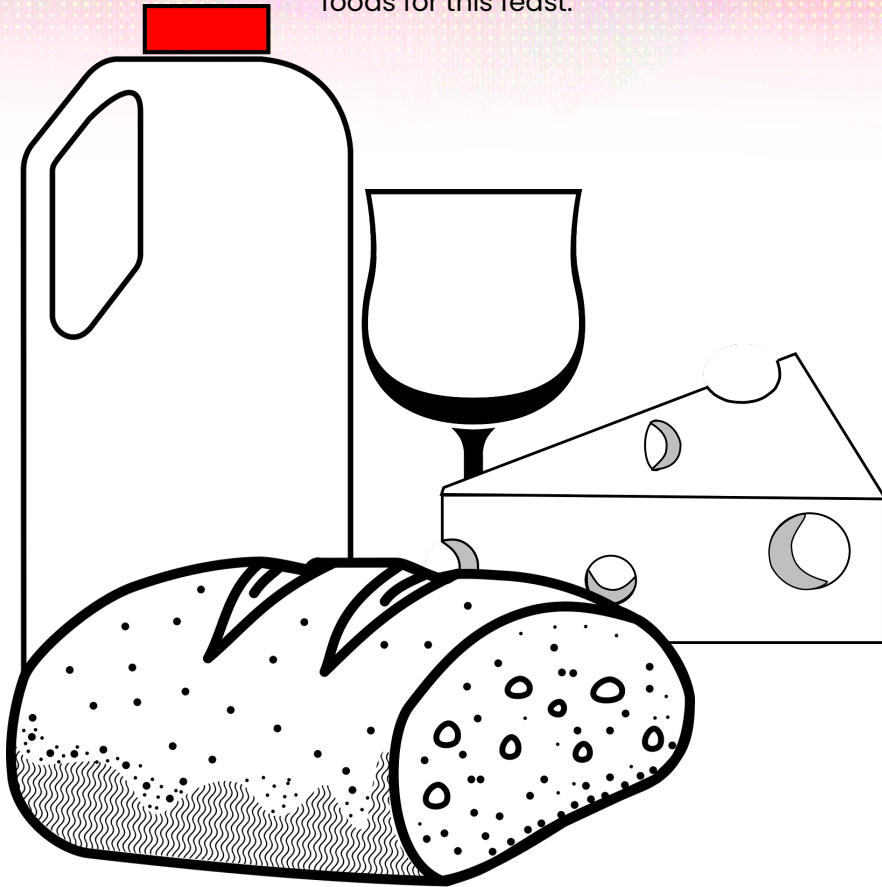


Draw & Color
