"The Gift of Joy"

Luke 1 December 14, 2025

THE BIG IDEA: Joy is simply the work of God in the soul of a person who chooses to make much of God and be obedient to what He asks of them. True joy is impossible to find apart from Jesus.

Luke 1:46-55 (ESV)

⁴⁶ And Mary said,

"My soul *magnifies* the Lord,

- and my spirit *rejoices* in God my Savior,
- for he has looked on the humble estate of his servant.

For behold, from now on all generations will call me blessed;

- for he who is mighty has done great things for me, and holy is his name.
- And his mercy is for those who fear him from generation to generation.
- He has shown strength with his arm; he has scattered the proud in the thoughts of their hearts;
- he has brought down the mighty from their thrones and exalted those of humble estate;
- he has filled the hungry with good things, and the rich he has sent away empty.
- He has helped his servant Israel, in remembrance of his mercy,
- as he spoke to our fathers, to Abraham and to his offspring forever."

Biblical "Joy"

- Joy is deeper and more enduring than circumstantial happiness.
- We were made for joy.
- Joy is received and experienced when we magnify God.
- To magnify is to zoom in and make large.

- Internally, spiritually, this is to choose something or someone and intentionally give them prominence in our lives!
- My Problem: my sin has cut me off from God, the source of Joy.
 - My response (and that of all humans) is to choose something else to magnify, and I wind up ultimately magnifying self.

Caesar: He is the emperor of one of largest and most sophisticated kingdoms in history

Mary: She is a teenage girl, having angelic visitations; bearing 'Son of God' whose kingdom will last forever; Her world is being rocked!

Our Failed Attempts at Joy:

- ✓ Achievment magnification
- ✓ Problem magnification
- ✓ Personal preference magnification
- ✓ All of these at their core: self-magnification

The Secret to Joy: 'My soul *magnifies the Lord*, and my spirit rejoices in God my Savior.'

- Keeps perspective on what is temporary and what is eternal.
- ✓ God's joy: the only <mark>lasting</mark> joy available in the universe
- ✓ We will spend our lives magnifying God or self in the search for joy
- ✓ Joy is the fruit of the Spirit (a work of God) in a soul that magnifies the Lord.
 - You choose to make more of God than of yourself (John 3:30)
 - o You choose obedience (Hebrews 12:1-3)
