

Carlos Manuel Zabala - Trumpet Soloist

Carlos Manuel Zabala is a trumpet and flugelhorn virtuoso originally from Uruguay, known for his diverse performances and innovative interpretations across genres. A graduate of John Hopkins' Peabody Institute, he has performed worldwide and taught at prominent music festivals. His playing has been described as "impressive and seemingly effortless" by the International Trumpet Guild. He is the recipient of numerous scholarships and awards.

Sandy Daelemans - Guest Accompanist (Piano & Organ)

Sandy Daelemans recently retired after a 35-year choral music career, most of it in Calvert County. She has also been a church musician for over 40 years, serving as a choral director, organist, pianist, children's choir director, handbell choir director, and director of music. Originally from PA and a graduate of Penn State, Sandy enjoys time with her husband, Gary, their family, and their dogs. In her free time, she enjoys reading, gardening, and baking.

Adedotun Olayemi - Director of Music Ministry

Adedotun "Ade" has come with a lot of training and experience over the past three decades in choral directing, vocal training, organ music performance, and worship service planning. He is currently a Colleague of the American Guild of Organists (CAGO). He has performed in various local and International Music events and worship services. He attended a choir pilgrimage to Salisbury Cathedral United Kingdom with the Choir at St. Andrew's Episcopal, College Park, Maryland as the guest organist in the summer of 2023, where he played all the daily evensong services on the four manual Pipe Organ at the Cathedral. As a music composer and writer, Ade has about fifty (50) choral music and hymn arrangements to his name.

Regarding tonight's maiden performance of "Emmanueli, O ku abo (Welcome Emmanuel)", Ade was inspired to write this piece in celebration of the birth of our Lord Jesus Christ - a King conceived and born as a baby to save mankind. It is with so much delight to present this song in Yoruba language (from Nigeria) which is a tonal language that centers around 3 basic pitches of speech (high, medium and low pitches). This song is particularly gifted to the choir at St. Martin's Lutheran Church, Annapolis, MD. in recognition of their dedication to the service of God in this community. Ade's wife and two of his children also sing with this choir.

Ade is also a Transportation Design Engineer with the Maryland Department of Transportation - State Highway Administration.
