<u>Liturgist/Scripture Reading</u> – One way to serve in our church is to be a liturgist at 11:00 or Scripture Reader at 9:30. In these roles, you help provide important hospitality to those joining us and leadership for the service. Training is offered to help prepare you. Talk to Pastor Jeff for more information or to indicate interest/curiosity.

Important Tax Change on Charitable Giving – Beginning in 2026, you may be able to deduct up to \$1,000 (\$2,000 for married couples) of your charitable giving, even if you take the standard deduction. Your generosity to Monroe UM Church not only advances God's mission, it may also reduce your tax bill!

<u>The Details</u>: Starting with gifts made in 2026, as set out in the One Big Beautiful Bill Act, individuals may deduct up to \$1,000, and married couples filing jointly may deduct up to \$2,000, from their taxable income for gifts to qualified charities, including their church. This is above the standard deduction. The universal tax deduction will reduce taxable income, not adjusted gross income. This applies only for cash donations, but gifts to donor-advised funds do not qualify.
