Define: Adoration

We adore what we desire most.

Desire always leads to devotion.

John 4:25-26 ESV

Discover: Jesus

Luke 2:8-20 ESV

God awakens the hearts of ordinary people.

Do Not Be Afraid.

Jesus is the Good News.

Jesus is the Savior, the Christ, & the Lord.

Go, See, & Do

1. Go: Move Toward Jesus
2. See: Experience Jesus
3. Do: Respond to Jesus

Develop: Know Jesus & Make Jesus Known

If my desires reveal my worship, what do they reveal about my heart right now?

Who do I know that needs Jesus?

Lord Jesus, awaken out desire for You above all else.

Start talking. Find a conversation starter to get you talking.

- What to you most desire for Christmas?

Start thinking. Ask a question to get you thinking.

- Read **Revelation 19:10**. Where do you have the greatest tendency to worship God's good creation instead of God Himself?
- Read **Luke 2:8-20**. How did the shepherds and Mary respond differently that night? How should we respond to the good news about Jesus?

Start sharing. Choose a question to create openness.

- Have you experienced a time when God showed up in the place you least expected it? What happened? What does this reveal about God?
- Share about a time you experienced the goodness of God. Did you take time to reflect upon what God had done? Why is taking time to reflect so important?

Start praying. Be bold and pray with power.

Father, awaken our desire for You above all else. Help us move toward You and see how wonderful You are. Help us take time to treasure Your goodness in our hearts this Christmas season. In Jesus' name we pray, amen.

Start doing. Commit to a step and live it out this week.

- Commit to pondering about Jesus in your heart and treasuring all the things He has done.
- Commit to sharing the good news and/or inviting someone to Church or Christmas Eve service this week.
