I have been going back and forth with the Hutton family in Costa Rica as they were explaining their situation with the Cabecar Indians and their annual Christmas parties. They need help with the food and gifts for the three works in Atirro, Nimari Nyak, and Grano de Oro. The Lord has graciously blessed in supplying the funds for these parties in times past, but things are going very slow this year with the donations. These parties draw many of the Cabecars out to hear the gospel which normally would not attend the church services.
