# Dear Friends and supporters,

I hope this update finds you well. As always, thank you for your faithful prayers and encouragement. God has been so present and gracious in this season of transition, and I'm grateful to share several important updates with you. This month marks the almost 1-year point of my new life in Brazil!

## Furlough & Graduate Program Update

This week I will be traveling back to the United States for a brief but planned furlough. After discussing this thoroughly with my Mission Field Director and receiving full approval, I will be taking a short furlough of approximately eight months. During this time, I will be completing the final clinical hours required to graduate from my Nurse Practitioner program.

This degree has been nearly two and a half years in the making, and these clinical hours are truly the final major step before graduation. I will be practicing full-time for about six months under the supervision of another Nurse Practitioner within a well-established practice. I am praising God for providing this opportunity—and for caring for every detail, including housing and transportation during this season. From the beginning, my heart behind pursuing this specialty has been to expand medical missions opportunities in the Amazon Basin. I continue to trust the Lord to use this additional training for His purposes in the region.

### Ministry Transition & Local Church Connection

As I prepare for this temporary transition, God has helped me with every detail of packing, organizing, and finalizing my affairs here in Brazil. I recently completed my final volunteer weeks at the Christian school and had the joy of helping with several church special events through planning and decorating.

During my time in the States, I am looking forward to being involved in a local church—attending, serving, and staying spiritually encouraged and connected while I complete my clinical hours.
